# Note from the Pastor WHO ARE YOU, O GOD? AND WHO AM I?



"Who are you, O God? And who am I?" For hours on end and often through the entire night, St. Francis would pose this question (prayer) to the Lord. It is a prayer with no "amen" for it never ends on this side of eternity. If we, indeed,

participate in the Divine Mystery, in the Life of God, then the more we know and understand, the more we realize how much more there is to know and understand. As soon as you think you've got it, you lose it only to discover that in your loss, you've gained at a much deeper level. Get it? Neither do I! But that doesn't keep me from asking. And I'm in some very good company.

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul. We all know the story of how he was blinded by the light, fell off his horse and then heard the question "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?" Like a good Jew he answered the question with the question, "Who are you Lord?" The answer: "I am Jesus who you persecute."

Well, that's news! Paul didn't even know Jesus so how could he be persecuting him? He was aiding in the stoning of these new followers of "The Way", that's who he was persecuting, not Jesus. Now, what's wrong with this picture?

"Love me, love my dog"...(Butch Knudsen). "Persecute my people, persecute me..." (Jesus). And so the question, "who are you, O God? And who am I?" We find the question first posed by Moses as he encounters the burning bush, "Who are you?" To which the bush responds, "I Am who I Am." Great! We are right back where we started from. See how hard it is to get a handle on God? The moment you think you've got him, you've lost him (her) (see what I mean?)

And yet (S)He asks us to seek Him. It's all very confusing. Is it any wonder that Paul is a bit discombobulated as he is sitting there on the ground blinded by the light? And this is what we call his conversion? Converted to what? Converted from believing that he had God by simply being a good, law abiding Pharisee to beginning to perceive that God, the infinite, unapproachable God can be found abiding in weak, mortal flesh... first in the person of Jesus and then in the Mystical Body of His followers. When it finally dawns on Paul where God is to be found he develops his theology of Mystical Body of Christ.

Who is God? We can't say and we don't know but now, at least we do know where to go looking for him. He's real close, next door, even living in our homes and hearts.

When the apostle Philip asks Jesus to show him the Father and that will be enough, Jesus responds by saying, "Philip, I have been with you all this time and you still don't see Him? You still don't know? Philip, look at me! He who sees me sees the Father!"

And it goes further. At the end of the Matthew's Gospel, the Lord tells us that He's always been here but some of us didn't know it or see Him for His incredible disguises as the naked, hungry, imprisoned, alone, homeless.

We are told to "Seek the Lord while He can be found. Call on Him while He is still near." So where's He going? Nowhere. And remember when we take the word 'nowhere' apart we have 'now here'. And He certainly is.

Well, are you ready to spend the night with Francis? Who are you O God? And who am I? Remember, there's no 'Amen' to this prayer.

## **EUCHARISTIC ADORATION**




