

Note from the Pastor



FIRST SUNDAY IN LENT

The last feast we celebrated before winter's dark interlude was the Baptism of the Lord. On coming out of the waters of the Jordan, the young carpenter from

Nazareth received from God his true name and identity. The Spirit hovered over him and the voice of the Almighty proclaimed, "You are my son, my beloved." That has to be pretty heady stuff. From a purely human point of view can you imagine what it must be like to realize that you can say to these stones, "Be bread", and they would turn into the staff of life. Now, that's power. But how do you use it? What does it really mean to be the son of God? Ah, that's the question for Jesus and, as the adoptive sons and daughters of God, for us as well.

But how and where do you discover what all of this means? Where can one go to understand what it means to have the fullness of life? The best place to discover that is in the Valley of Death, the desert. And so led by the Spirit, Jesus goes into the deserted place, the desert for 40 days and 40 nights on a journey of self-discovery and, if we are to be his followers, so must we. Welcome to the desert. Welcome to Lent.

But why the desert? Why would we go to this place of dryness and emptiness? It would seem that if we wanted to drink deeply of the waters of life we would go to the Oasis, to the rainforest where vegetation and life is lush, where we can fill our bellies and minds with the sweet fruit that surrounds us that is just ripe for the picking. But no, it is God's spirit that leaves him to the desert and where he goes, so must we.

But why? Someone asked Lawrence of Arabia that same question to which he responded, "Because it's clean." It is not cluttered; there is nothing there to preoccupy your mind. There are no superficial pastimes to keep you busy. It is just you and the vast emptiness that at first glance seems so dead. There is nothing there. Or is there? It is only when we are reduced to the bare essentials that we begin to discover what is truly essential. Most of our lives are fritted away on useless preoccupations that keep us very busy but take us nowhere. It is only when we are lead to the nowhere, the desert without any visible means of sustenance that we slowly begin to discover that we are "now-here" with all that is essential and all that we need. But it is a pretty scary proposition for as St. Mark tells us today in the Gospel, "We will find ourselves among the wild beasts."

When our superficial satiations are taken away we find ourselves hungry, alone, and afraid. We want to bolt back to where we came from. But if we are truly led by the Spirit we stand still in the desert and listen. The first voices we hear will be those of the wild beasts, of our fears and our fantasies and the good times and easy days past. If we are strong enough and humble enough we continue to stand still and listen even deeper. Now the external crutches of our culture are no longer there to prop us up and we slowly begin to perceive that there is an internal light and power that gives us life. Not only was Jesus in the desert with the wild beasts but the angels came to wait on him and it is the promise of God that we too have our angels.

Are you ready for the journey? There is only one way to enter into the desert of Lent and that is believe or not, unprepared. We leave behind our fail-safe systems and come empty handed into the desert of life, the desert of Lent. Only when we are armed with the works of the desert: prayer, fasting and almsgiving, will we discover that the desert is teeming with life.

And it's all about life.

EUCHARISTIC ADORATION 60 MINUTES

A few weeks ago the last of the Christmas decorations were being put away and now it's already Lent. Most of us have hardly had time to break our New Year's resolutions much less start thinking about our Lenten disciplines.

Maybe we'd do better to put OUR decisions aside for a moment and find out what GOD has in mind for us. What He wants of us this Lent may be something we've never thought of, or something that surprises us. Jesus said to His apostles, "Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while." (Mk 6:31-32) And so they did. (adapted from The Little Black Book, by Bishop Ken Untener)

Put yourself in that scene for a time; **60** Minutes would be perfect. Make it just the Lord and yourself, alone in a quiet place. This Monday you have an opportunity to do just that. He will be present in the monstrance during our day of Eucharistic Adoration, from 9 am to 7 pm. Our day of prayer ends with Benediction. Come! Rest a while. Talk straight with Him and the two of you will surely come up with some Lenten plans.


