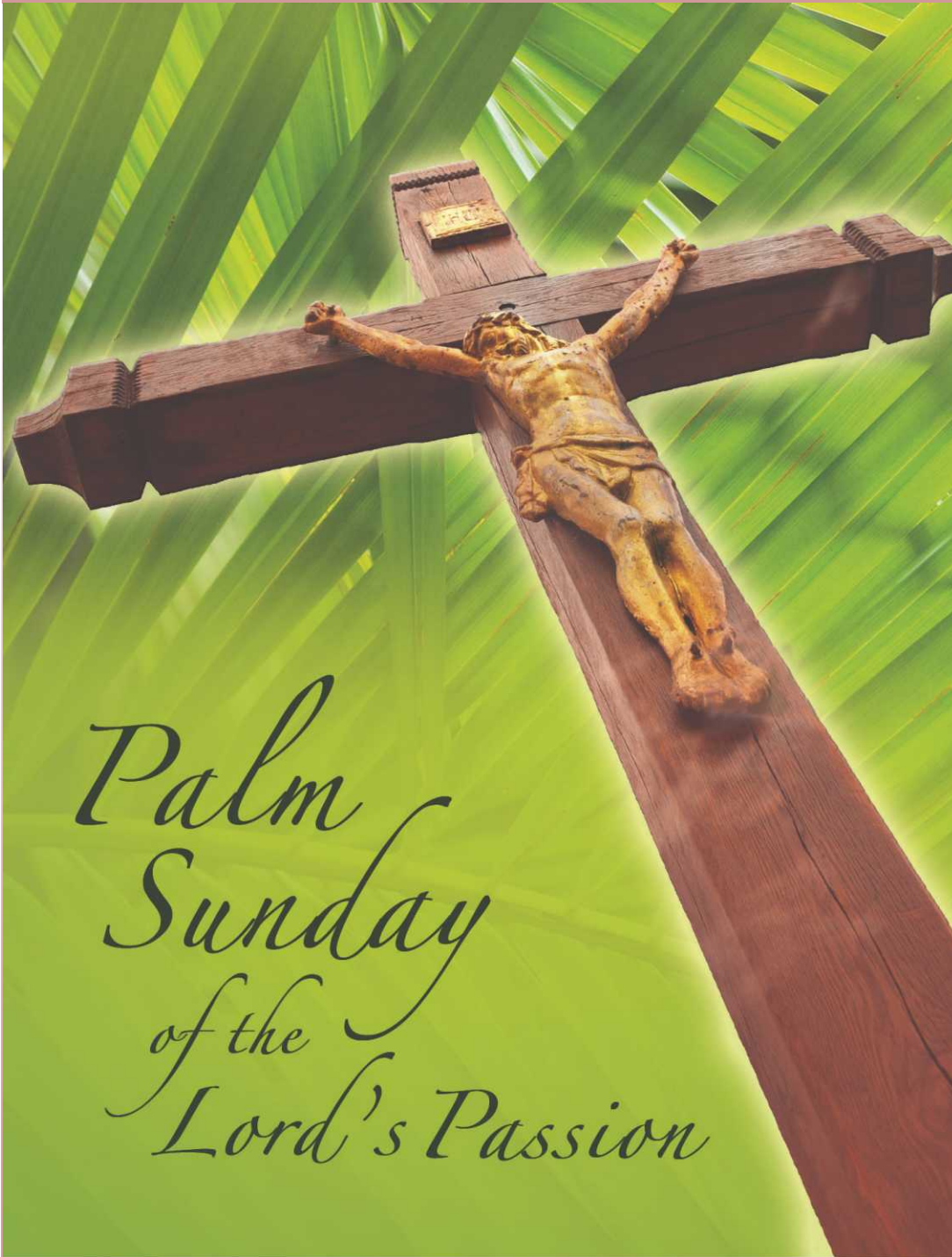

### Note from the Pastor



On April 1st, 67 years ago, my parents presented their third born to the Pastor, Fr. Cogo at Mother Cabrini Parish for Baptism. After the Baptism, my mother, jokester that she was, chortled to the priest, "April Fool! We're Jewish!" "Too late, lady, he's baptized". And it took. Next Saturday at the Easter Vigil, Destiny Gamboa who has been preparing for this journey for some time now will be taking the plunge into the baptismal bath and it will be no joke. Please, God, may it take and be the beginning of a new life for her. A life in Christ.

Shall we journey with her and our candidates for full communion? It can be life changing for us as well. All we need do is go along for the ride with a radically open heart. Many of us have gone through our sacraments unaware of their power for transformation. Now, one of the beauties of our Catholic faith is that while we cannot be baptized or confirmed again, we can journey with those who are being baptized and thus enter into a deeper relationship with our God and each other. But it won't happen if we stay home.

Today is Palm Sunday. There are so many people on our campus today. (Catholics love a freebie). Now, some of us won't be back until those palms turn brown, are burnt and ground into ashes for Ash Wednesday. But today, I would like to propose an alternative. If you truly heard the Passion proclaimed today, I now invite you to come back again on Thursday, Friday and Saturday to fully enter into the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus because if we do, there is the possibility that we will come to realize it is not only His Passion and His Resurrection that we are celebrating, but ours as well. Where the Master has gone, the disciples must follow. And as baptized disciples who truly seek the fullness of life, we have no alternative but to go and follow.

On Thursday evening at 7:00 pm, we will gather to begin the Sacred Triduum (the holy three days) by following the Leader. The Greeks called Jesus the Archegos (the pathfinder). Where He goes and what He does is the path and model that leads to a full life. And where the Master has gone, we must follow. What the Master has done, we must do. And on Thursday, He washes His disciple's feet. We are then encouraged and given the opportunity to do the same. We do this in preparation for the banquet we are to receive, the bread of eternal life and the cup of salvation, the cup of the covenant.

On Friday, at 7:00 pm, we go where no man has ever gone before. We go with Jesus into the heart of darkness, into the heart of death. But we go in a brand new way. We go

without fear, we watch Jesus embrace the cross and the suffering of a sinful humanity. It looks like utter defeat and, in a purely human sense, it is. But it will lead to life, full life here on our earth and eternal life. From the Stations of the Cross, to the living stations in the afternoon; to the Passion of the Christ at night we will not merely be spectators but followers. There is no other way, He is the Way.

On Saturday night at 7:30 pm as darkness settles over the earth, a light will be lit. A light came into the world that the darkness could not overcome. And it is ours. Where death has happened, resurrection must follow. And it does. It is on this night that Destiny and we by participation will be plunged into the baptismal waters of death and immersed from the baptismal waters of Eternal Life. Grace will flow and we shall become new creations.

Come. All has been prepared. The cross is ready, the table is set, the waters are flowing. All this awaits your presence.
