Note from the Pastor



HAPPY BIRTHDAY, BUTCH!

Last Saturday was our night watchman and my housemate Butch's 67 birthday. "What do you want for your birthday Butch?" I taunted. "To be left alone," he chortled. "Can I republish the article I wrote about you and the bird?" "No," he sneered. I'm sorry. I can't resist.

Happy Birthday Butch!

The man needs a dog or something. He really does! Ever since his beloved pooch Dribbles (or Puddles or something like that) went up to doggie heaven our night watchman Butch Knudson has not been...well...quite right.

A couple of weeks ago as he was making his rounds on a Friday night checking the doors and the lights, he went into Mrs. Yearly's 6th grade classroom to make sure all was well. As he entered, he heard a familiar sound. It was the chirping of a parakeet in a gilded cage in the corner of the room. Now, no one will ever confuse our Butch with St. Francis but you've got to admit, he loves small animals and children (it's the adults who have to watch out). As he went over to this song bird of God, he noticed something strange. The bird seemed content and happy singing away, but as he looked closer he noticed there was neither food nor water in its cage. This isn't good, he thought and it certainly isn't right. If kids want pets they have to take care of them better than this. "I'll take care of you little fellow, as soon as I finish locking up, I'll be right back."

It was already 11:30 pm and the only place that he knew he could get what he wanted was the all night Jewel. So off he went. Coming back about an hour later with a package of bird seed and a bottle of water, Butch filled the cage container with food and enough water for the weekend. The bird chirped merrily away seemingly content at this caregiver's care. She was so content she didn't flitter around her cage and trusted him to put the food just where it belonged as well as the water. As he closed the cage door he was at least impressed that the class cleaned out the bottom of the cage. But then, if the bird has nothing to eat, what's to clean up? He shrugged his shoulders, smiled at the bird, and left.

On Monday morning, he returned to the school and gently chided the school's principal, Mrs. Collins. "You know, Mrs. Collins, if you're going to have an animal in the school, you've got to feed it. It's just not fair to leave the little critters all weekend with no food or water." Mrs. Collins nodded and assured him that she would look into it but felt

it quite odd that there would be a bird in the classroom. The teachers had met earlier in the year to discuss just such matters.

Later in the day when Mrs. Collins went up to the 6th grade classroom to check on the situation, she encountered Mrs. Yearly, who also had a rather puzzled look on her face. "The kids must be pulling a prank because look, there is food and water in the cage and all that this bird requires to be happy is to change its batteries from time to time to keep it chirping, moving and singing. After all, it's only a mechanical, plastic bird." Mrs. Collins smiled the smile of recognition and explained what had happened. When the kids came into school, they too, marveled at the food and water for the bird but were also given a marvelous moral insight. How wonderful and nice of Mr. Butch to go out in the middle of the night to get food and water for one of God's little creatures. Maybe he really is St. Francis in disguise. And so the children sent him a thank you note and a book about dogs.

Now if you see Butch walking the halls, late at night locking doors, don't mention this to him. The classroom was rather dark and it wasn't easy to tell the true origin of the species. But his response was nothing less than great and loving care for God's very special creatures. And that makes him one, too.

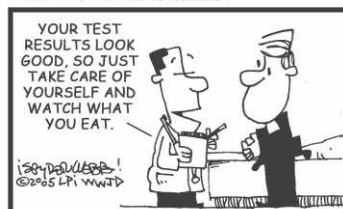


Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:
