

Note from the Pastor



The First Sunday of Lent

Shhhh, Quiet Please

And now we begin again. The forty days of Lent are upon us and in the genius of the Church's liturgical cycle, just in the nick of time. The winter doldrums must now give way to the lengthening of days. The word "Lent" means lengthening. It is a time to elongate and expand our soul so as to receive the Son of Justice. It is a time of preparation and, please God, a time for a little quiet.

A couple of weeks ago I took a few days with my brother, sister-in-law and my cousins from Arizona for a little R & R (no, no, not rushing and running; rest and relaxation). And rest I did. It is so wonderful from time to time to get out of gear and idle for a while. The older I get the more convinced I become that we are way too frenetic and preoccupied. For years now I have been advocating that one should not just "do something" but "stand there." Today I wish to add to that, a little quiet. Shhhh.


I spent my week on the big island of Hawaii. I am told it is the least impressive of all the islands but for me it was just fine. Most of the days I did nothing. Nothing. Oh, I had some wonderful conversations and meals with my family but the majority of time was spent with a good book or just whiling away the day. I did go to the mandatory luau and one day we took a tour around the entire island. On the tour we were able to walk through the lava tubes where the molten lava oozed out to the sea. It was quite an impressive walk. As I was walking in wonder and awe I heard a young voice behind me cry out in pain, "Oh my God, my life is over." My ears perked up to hear what caused such an anguished cry and then he said, "My iPhone just went dead." I froze in my tracks, spun around, smiled and just looked at the kid. He stopped and smiled back. And without a word we had a wonderful conversation. We didn't need words. Enough had already been said. I was reminded of the day I came home from the city on the Metra to be the only person in the car who did not have his face in a screen or talking on a cell phone. That was the day the girl in front of me incessantly talked loudly (you

would think she was using two cans and a string to talk) to her girlfriend for one half hour without stop. It was obvious this was annoying the rest of the passengers so I finally quietly said, "Uhh, excuse me, umm, but I think you may be annoying the passengers." To which she responded to the girl to whom she was speaking, "I gotta go, some people on this train are making my life miserable." She hung up and the rest of the car burst into applause.

Shhhh. Quiet. It is Lent. It is a time for listening, not talking. I challenged the children on Ash Wednesday to spend at least 5-10 minutes every day in total, absolute silence. Listening. It is the reason that God gave us two ears and only one mouth. The really important listening is learning how to hear the sound of silence. It is the silence of God that speaks volumes. But we will never hear this small, still, wordless voice if we remain a-twitter.

Shhhh. Quiet. It is Lent.


