# Note from the Pastor



#### Trinity Sunday Shall We Dance?

We hear the cry these days, "Are there no more absolutes!?" To which we can respond unequivocally, "Yes, God is absolute." And this absolute is a relative! Or, more accurately this unchangeable, immutable, incomprehensible Pureness of Being is a relationship.

Today is Trinity Sunday. It is the day that we Christians profess and proclaim that our God is one. So far, so good. Here we stand in accordance with the other great monotheistic religions of Judaism and Islam. We then go on to profess and proclaim that this one God is three persons. What? In the physical world one does not equal three. But in the world of God, which is the world of love, it must. If, indeed, God is love then the very nature of love is to create and go outside itself. Love always focuses on the well being of the other becoming self forgetful.

Now there is a truism that states we can only love insofar as we have been loved. If God is love then God loves perfectly, fully, giving everything to the beloved. Now, insofar as the beloved receives this love, it becomes capable of responding with love. And the bond between these two lovers is love itself. So in our Christian mythological language, we have the Father eternally loving the Son and the Son eternally loving the Father and the bond of love between them is the Holy Spirit. This love is so complete that these three are one. It is the dance of love where it not only takes two to tango but the dance is so explosive that it goes outside of itself and creates an entire universe. Talk about a big bang. Talk about dancing with the stars!

Now, since God is a relationship everything that God creates is also in relationship. Nothing, no one, no-thing exists by itself. Every star, every planet, every tree, every person is in relationship with something or someone else. Look through the most powerful telescope and most accurate microscope and **you'll see the same thing: the planets and stars and** galaxies and now maybe even multi-universes dancing around each other. Molecules and atoms, protons, electrons and neutrons are doing the tango. Even matter and anti-matter, dark holes and dark energies are part of the dance. And us? What about us. Not only are we invited into the dance, but the God of the universe dances us. And He's a pretty good dancer.

All of creation, all of life is in relationship. From the seed to the soil to the water to the sun, beautiful life is produced and has the potential to bear wonderful fruit. If the relationship, however, gets out of kilter and there is not enough water or no sun, the plant and consequently the fruit will be stunted. It is the same way with us. While we come into being by a biological relationship, we will not and cannot grow and flourish without the quintessential element of love that is God. The boy Jesus grew in wisdom, age and grace because he was perfectly capable of receiving the totality of the love of His Father, God. And He had the capacity to receive that love because of the love, we are told, of His mother who did not pass on to Him the normal fears and anxieties and shame of diminished capacity. As the boy Jesus gazed into His mother's eyes, He saw the divine reflection back into His and grew into who He was, the Son of God.

Now that's fine for Jesus, but what about us? Here's our conundrum. We can only love insofar as we have been loved. We can only receive love insofar as we have a capacity to receive it. The newborn is a black hole of need. Without continual and constant love, the child's capacity for love begins to diminish and ultimately die. The more it's loved, the greater its capacity grows to receive. The problem is that none of us have been loved perfectly. Many of us suffer from diminished capacity. And yet the hunger never ever goes away. We become restless, hungry, searching for the ever illusive love. Well, search no more.

St. Augustine said it all, "Our hearts are restless until they rest in Thee, O Lord." The heart, indeed, is the lonely hunter. And we search for that love in all sorts of places. Most people and places cannot perfectly fulfill what we need. But God can. God is love. One of my favorite questions to especially adolescents in Confession is, "Tell me about your relationship to the Lord. Tell me how well you know Jesus." Today we are invited into that dance of love. Today we are invited to receive and have our capacity for receiving expand, but there is only one who can do it: our one God, our three persons, our love.
