## Note from the Pastor



### Gaudete!

I love the seasons. I love the change of seasons. Maybe it has something to do with the rhythms of life and our essential need for variety. In some way the seasons are the seasoning, the spice of life. "Seasons Greetings" and "Good Seasons" are kissing cousins. And what is true for our climatological seasons is even more true for our liturgical seasons.

I love our liturgical seasons. Talk about the rhythms of life. By the time we are through with the Easter season and Pentecost and Corpus Christi, I can't wait for some good old fashioned green Ordinary Time. But after 30 some weeks of it, Ordinary Time gets, well, ordinary. And so we change. Happy Advent. Happy New Year.

And now we begin again. The readings change (you've got to love Isaiah), the texts change (the Gloria is now omitted), the music changes (Oh Come, Oh Come, Emmanuel), and like the leaves in the Fall, the colors change. I am glad I'm not colorblind. The reds, the greens, the violets and even (for the rebellious) the blues all add to the mix of the liturgical seasons. In the early centuries, Advent was a long penitential season (Christmas was not moved to December 25 until the eighth century) and purple, after having been a royal color became a color of penance. All throughout Lent purple or violet is worn. The same is true for Advent. Purple it is... except for today.

You've got to love the Catholic Church. If it takes anything seriously, it takes the Incarnation seriously. And that means the Divine enters the physical and makes it holy and the things the body loves to do are basically good. So party hardy. And today we do. Today is Gaudete Sunday. In the midst of our penance during Lent and our preparation during Advent, the Church says, Take five, take a break.

The name "Gaudete" is Latin for "Rejoice!" I can't come to this Sunday without having a smile on my face. I'm smiling because even in the midst of a season, there is a mini-season. In the midst of a period of penance, the Church says Rejoice! It comes from the introit of the Mass that used to be sung. Today's comes from St.

Paul's letter to the Philippians that sings, "Rejoice in the Lord always! Again I say, Rejoice! Everyone should see how unselfish you are for the Lord is near. Dismiss all anxiety from your minds. Present your needs to God in every form of prayer and petitions full of gratitude. And God's own peace, which is beyond all understanding, will stand guard over your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus." You can't sing that or even read it and not have a smile come upon your face.

What I love, however, most about today are the colors. Show your true colors. The color of today is rose. Not purple, not white but a combination of penance and praise mixed together to allow us for one day to rejoice. Mary Queen has not owned a rose colored vestment until today. Today I don our gay apparel for the first time. And it is brought to us by one who loved to rejoice in the Lord, Brenda Scanlon. In memory of her, her family has purchased for us a new rose colored vestment. And when we put it on, we have to smile. In the midst of the pain and penance of life, there is always joy.

Rejoice in the Lord always! Again say, Rejoice!

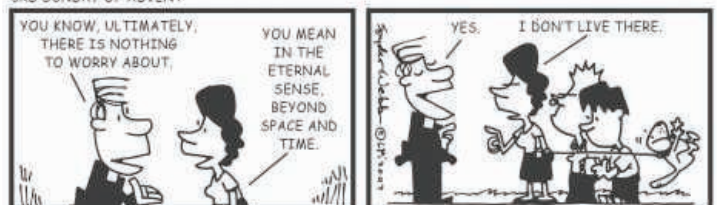

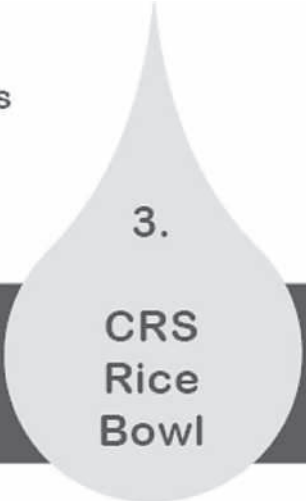
