

# Note from the Pastor



Two weeks ago, we ordained 5 young men to the priesthood for the Diocese of Joliet. Today and this week coming up, I ask you to think about your own vocation and the

possible vocations of your children and grandchildren.

Vocation is a calling.

I get a lot of mileage on my mouth. And I have been trained in the 2<sup>nd</sup> City School of Improv. Sometimes when I speak, people laugh (I'm never quite sure at what). And sometimes after I have spoken they will come up to me and say something that drives me right up the wall. "Father, you know you really missed your calling." My usual response is to glare at them and say, "Excuse me!? I certainly hope not." That's a pretty unfair response but it comes from a place very deep inside that tells me that of all the things I have blown and screwed up in my life, the one thing that I didn't, the one thing I have never doubted, is my vocation. Every time I have turned my back to run away from it, I run smack back into it. I may have missed the mark, I may have misstepped and misspoken; I know I have mistaken, but I did not miss my calling. My vocation.

Now, don't get vocation and career mixed up. A career is something you choose to do. A vocation is something someone else chooses for you and calls you to. You are not the initiator of a vocation, you simply respond by saying yes or no. God is the initiator. It is God's call. How? Well, to tell the truth, He doesn't use direct dialing very often. Then how? Through His continuing incarnation in the world, first manifest perfectly through Jesus and then (a little more imperfectly) through His Body in space and time, the People of God, the Body of Christ, the Church.

As Jesus walked along the shore of the sea of Galilee he saw fishermen and said to them, "Follow me." That's it. That's the call. Sometimes Jesus didn't do the calling directly; on several occasions John the Baptist said to his disciples, "Look there is the Lamb of God, follow Him." And they did. When Jesus noticed them following Him, He asked them, "What are you looking for?" And they responded, "Where do you dwell?" "Come, follow me, I'll show you." Where does Jesus dwell? Where does He live? In the heart of the Father. And He invites each of us in our own vocations to do exactly the same thing. And let me tell you this.

When you dance in your vocation, when you follow the call, when you are obedient to the summons of God, there is a surety and security that you are not wasting your life. You are being obedient to your calling. You are doing exactly what you are supposed to do. Sadly, however, many of us miss our vocation. Sometimes we miss it because the noise around us is so loud we can't hear the voice when it calls. But most often the voice never speaks. The voice never asks. That's the greater shame because the voice is ours, the Church, the Body of Christ on earth.

For almost forty years now I have heard the term "crisis" used along with the word "vocation." It has gone on so long now that the "vocation crisis" has become institutionalized. And it doesn't seem to be turning around. What's happened? Has God stopped calling? Are the lures of the modern world so great that our young people cannot hear the voice of God? Or have we, the people of God, just given up? God still calls. God never stops calling. But we have. We don't even try any more.

Time was (and it wasn't all that long ago) when a mother would look at her brood of kids and know (especially if you were Irish and from Chicago) that one might become a policeman and one might be a politician and one, please God, please God would become a priest or a nun. To have a son a priest or a daughter a religious sister was such a gift. Parents encouraged their children toward the religious life. And if there was the spark in the kid's eye, the entire church community bolstered it. Sister would look out over her entire class and say, "Okay, who wants to be a priest? Who wants to be a nun?" and all the hands would go up. She knew, however, by eighth grade, freshman year in high school which ones really had it. And she continued to call them. Call. Vocation. We do the calling. Do you get it? Sadly, we stopped. And so have vocations.

Now, don't get me wrong, not all callings are to the religious life. The call to marriage, the call to the single life, are real, legitimate vocations. It is not so important what we are called to, as long as we don't miss the call. There will be no vocations in the future if we are not vocation conscious. And right now we are not. So what are we waiting for? Next week, I'll try to answer this question.
