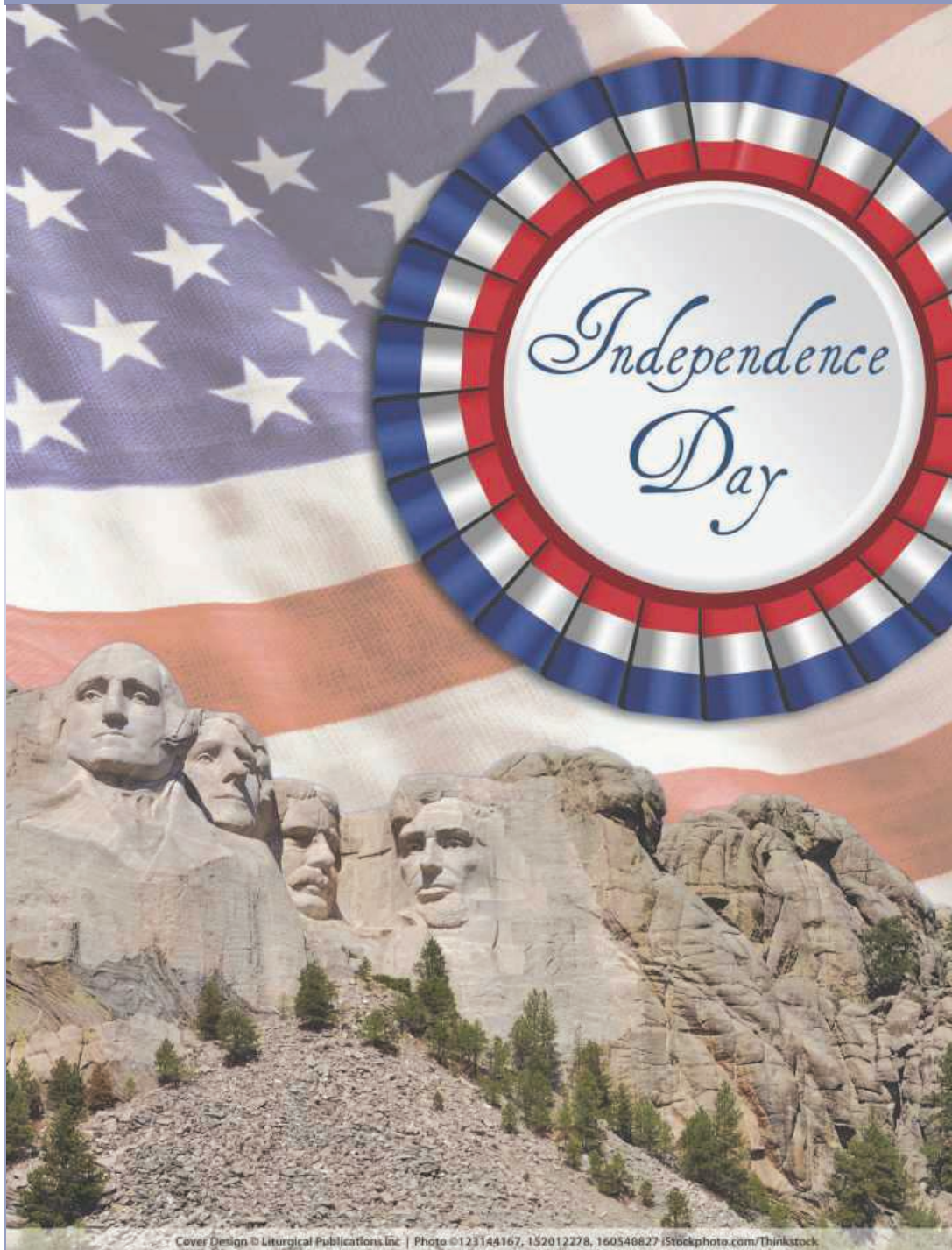

Note from the Pastor



As a young priest I once walked into a classroom of rambunctious fifth graders screaming at the top of their lungs. Unable to get their attention by normal means I banged my book on the desk and shouted, "I demand pandemonium." And the room fell silent. Silence! It is music to my ears. Last week I wrote about the power of music. This week, as we begin to slide into serious summer, I write to solicit a little silence. Quiet, please.

Someone once asked the Buddha what was the secret of life. He responded, "Awareness!" And what is awareness? "Silence." And what is silence? "Awareness." We all know the sound of two hands clapping but what is the sound of one hand clapping? It is the sound of silence. And the language of God? The older I become the more aware I am that it truly is the language of silence. In the silence of the universe, God speaks (in silence).

By my mid-thirties, I remember complaining to the Lord one day how frenetic and busy my life was. I was wrestling with what at that time seemed to be insoluble problems. "I don't know what to do, I don't know what to say, I don't know where to go. Tell me, tell me, what do I do?" Now I do not hear the silent voice of God too often but I swear at that moment God broke his silence and spoke. He said, "Oh, shut up!" In shock I responded, "How long?" "For about three years." I'm still working at it.

What is it about silence that is so important to our lives and yet so difficult to enter into? The problem is that silence, at least initially, can be deafening. I remember picking up a young hitchhiker in Hopkins Park (don't try that today) and he asked if I could turn on the radio. He tuned into a god awful acid rock station and it seemed to calm him down. After about five minutes I turned it off. He began to get jittery and nervous. "Can I turn it back on?" "No." After another three minutes he asked me to stop the car and he got out. He couldn't stand the sound of silence. It was just too loud. Way too many things start bubbling up to the surface when we do not have the noisy distractions that keep us from facing our own inner realities, our inner demons. But if we are able to persevere, we break through that nervousness and loneliness into peaceful solitude.

One of our greatest fears is loneliness. We live overactive, distracted lives in order to keep from feeling lonely. We watch TV, we call friends, we text, we eat (and eat, and eat) to try to fill a void, an emptiness. We incessantly search the internet to keep this empty feeling at bay. Much wiser would be to turn off the noise. And face it. And then feel it. But feel it all the way through. Because it is at the bottom of our loneliness, the bottom of our emptiness, the bottom of our silence and aloneness that brings us to true Presence, that brings us to God. The Divine is always there, but we cover Him up with so many distractions and so much noise. And so we try it again... to enter into the silence.

This is the month of July. It is our tradition to shut everything down. No meetings. No running around. No idle talk (even the homilies should be shorter). Our mantra for this month is: "Don't just do something, stand there." And be quiet.

Listen to the Lord as he speaks in silence. "Be still and know that I am God." And in that stillness, in that silence, God speaks.

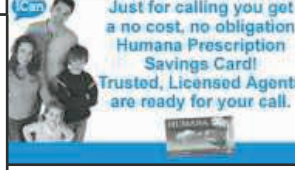
