Note from the Pastor



THE (SEMI) HOLY FAMILY

Today is the feast of the Holy Family. In my 1950's children's picture book, the Holy Family were drawn with the boy Jesus making little crosses in His father's woodshop while Mary looked on lovingly. The perfect family. The model for all families. There He was. The little blue-eyed boy with curly blonde hair whittling away at miniature instruments of death. That was the perfect picture. But we didn't buy it.

Even then, we knew it could not be so idyllic and perfect. First of all, where were His brothers and sisters? Part of being a real family is to have someone to fight with. He was an only child (my brother was an only child). And then there was St. Joseph whom we pictured answering the door and saying, "Come on in. Mary, the boy and I were just about to start saying the Rosary." (At least that is what Sister would have us believe.) No, the Holy Family was nothing like my family. My mother, however, would invoke their name from time to time as she screamed, "Gesu, Maria and Giuseppe, will you kids stop fighting, you're driving me nuts! I'm going to end up in the insane asylum." Ah, family. You gotta love it.

And I do. Ask any kid, ask any adult, and even a teenager on their better days, what's the most important thing in your life? The answer is almost always the same. My family. My nutty, screwy, wonderful, dysfunctional, happy, sad, loving (most of the time) family. There's nothing like it in the world.

I love to see the glow on the face of a young father right after the birth of his first born. I love to remind him of what his wife already intuitively and bodily knows; now, everything changes. Nothing will never, ever be the same. Now, you're family. All bets are off for you programming your life to unfold the way you want it to. Your children will make sure that doesn't happen.

And yet we keep on picturing in our mind the ideal family of *Ozzie and Harriet* or *Father Knows Best*. It is a family that does not now and has never existed. Not even the Holy Family. Especially not the Holy Family. Here we have a 15 year old girl pregnant and her fiancé is not the father. Now, you can tell stories of angels all you want, but who is going to believe it.

When the baby is born, Joseph takes him as his own and bears the gossipy shame of a cuckold man. When the boy turns 12, he takes off on His own and when His parents finally frantically find Him, His response is basically, "What's your problem?" When He begins to do His teaching, and His mother and cousins come to see Him, His response is, "Who is my mother?" That had to sting. But they are still family. And one of the remarkable things that young Jesus did on that day was to extend the meaning of family not to just blood relationships but to all who hear His word and keep it. This is the basis for the so called modern family. Family is now not just based on blood or on tribe but on love. If, as He teaches, God is love and love is His father, then those who love are family.

In 1980 I lived with one such family. Living in Hopkins Park at the time and living in community, I found myself the head of one fascinating family. When the 1980 census came to our door, we sat down at the kitchen table (all eight of us and all with different last names) to fill out the form. Who was the father? I was the father. Who was the mother? Well, we didn't have any mother but we did have four sisters: Sister Mary Cecilia – 83, Sister Mary Timothy – 79, Sisters Janet and Margaret – both in their 40's, Lewis Holm – 21, Michael Rolland – 20 and Harvey (actually Harvey was my dog but we loved him so much that he was obviously part of the family). The United States government never questioned my family.

Next October, our Holy Father, Francis is calling an extraordinary synod on the family. If last year was the year of faith maybe this year should be the year of the family. But what is the family to look like? The answer is, probably messy. Some will be blended, some will have a single parent as its head. Many will have step-brothers and sisters and step-parents. Some will have parents of the same orientation but, alas, I'm afraid very few will look like Ozzie or Harriet or even June Cleaver. They will look much more like Jesus (the illegitimate child) and Mary (the mother out of wedlock) and Joseph (who embraced them with his love). That's a family. That's the Holy Family. It is a family based on faith and love and the word of love incarnate, our Lord Jesus Christ. And that's enough to be family.

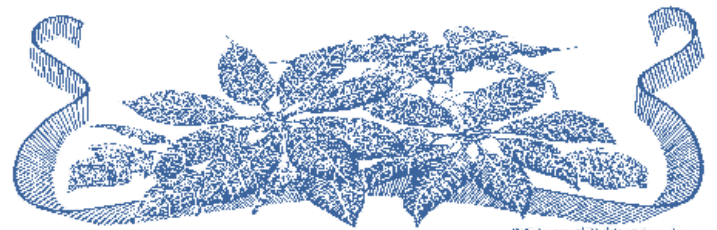
