Note from the Pastor



This Sunday the Church celebrates two of her earliest and most well-known Saints, Peter and Paul. These two saints are known for preaching the Gospel and building the early Church. Their zeal and skill in preaching the Gospel won many converts even in the face of persecution, and led each to his own martyrdom in Rome.

Having lived in Naperville for the past two years, any mention of Saint Peter and Paul has an additional meaning for me. Saint Peter and Paul were mentioned frequently, but not as saints themselves. Instead, their names were spoken to refer to “the other Catholic Church downtown” or the arch rivals of the school basketball team. I suspect that in “Elmhurst speak”, the Immaculate Conception has taken on a similar meaning to refer to “the other Catholic Church downtown.”

Having many different parishes nearby creates an opportunity to experience one of the rich beauties of our Church. Each parish has its own character, its own personality, and its own history. Despite the uniqueness of each community, one can find familiar liturgy, hear the Gospel being preached, and meet and visit with other Catholics who are on the same journey of faith as we are. It has been profound for me as I have experienced parishes in different cultures, languages, and even on other continents to marvel at how, despite the superficial differences, the core faith in the love of God and the power of Jesus’ saving death is universal.

Saint Peter and Saint Paul are excellent models and intercessors for us as disciples who are called to proclaim the good news in a society as diverse and multi-cultural our own. They both had experiences of Jesus’ presence that inspired both of them to conversion and filled them with a desire to build up the Church. They show us how, with the help of the Holy Spirit, each of us can preach the Gospel by witnessing to our own experiences of God’s care for us. That kind of preaching which speaks not of what someone else told us but of what we have come to believe from our own lives’ struggles and successes is very powerful. It can speak to anyone from any particular land, culture, or even parish affiliation because it speaks from the heart and to our common experience as human beings made in the image and likeness of God.

May God bless you with the courage, wisdom, and zeal to see the many situations in which you are called to witness to the Gospel. You will be surprised at the unlikely situations that discipleship leads you into. Without a doubt, you will also be surprised, as Saint Peter and Paul probably were, at how God provides you with the grace to witness to others in many different situations the love God has already given to you.

Saint Peter and Saint Paul, pray for us.
