# Note from the Pastor



Welcome to anyone visiting Mary Queen of Heaven Church on this Independence Day weekend! July 4<sup>th</sup> is one of the great feasts of summer, and I hope that you were able to enjoy a proper assortment of grilled meats,

potato or macaroni salad, and strawberries or watermelon with family and friends. We are able to enjoy this holiday because of the efforts and sacrifices of those who fought so that our country could be free for such celebrations with family, friends, and whatever summer food delights us.

In addition to celebrating and giving thanks for the freedoms won for us when our country was founded, Independence Day also gives us an opportunity to reflect on the role of independence and freedom in our life and our society. Pope Francis says "Before all else be free persons." What does it mean to be free? There is a tendency to think of freedom as being able to do what we want, independent from the interference of others or even the natural or moral laws that govern the world. Indeed, we should be free to choose. God created us with free will and respects our ability to use that will for a reason. The Holy Father continues, "Freedom means knowing how to reflect on what we do, knowing how to evaluate which are the behaviors that make us grow." How do we know what makes us grow? "Always choosing the good," the Pope says.

As children of God, we are challenged to seek greater goods, not out of slavery to a law, but as a free choice to pursue God's love. We are called to choose Him who is the fullness of goodness, and to seek to bring others into that good by showing them the joy that is the reward of using our freedom well to rise above the compromised goods that the world presents us.

Knowing the good when we are faced with a choice is not always an easy task. Choosing the good can be tricky, because it is easy to think that what seems good and rewarding for me is the best good, although it may not be. The Pope says, "being free to always choose the good is challenging, but [choosing the good] will make you persons with a backbone, who know how to face life, [and live as] courageous and patient persons." By training ourselves to choose the

best good, we become who we are meant to be, people who freely choose to love God. Choosing Him who is good leads us to a greater freedom, the freedom to love and be loved with the love that seeks to freely serve and not a love that makes us slaves to being served.

May God bless you with the true freedom that choosing His goodness provides.
