

Note from the Director of Faith Formation



5 Loaves, 2 Fish and Hankering for More

In the Gospel today, Jesus feeds the multitude with a skimpy five loaves and

two fish AND has leftovers. Before Jesus comes to the rescue He tells the Apostles to "give them something to eat yourselves." The Apostles didn't know where to start; so many people, so little food. Jesus didn't expect them to do it alone. This miracle shows how a feast can come from a measly offering when serving the Kingdom of God. In seeking the Kingdom of God we discover the Lord Himself!

Hunger comes in various forms: hunger pains for nourishment, an appetite for knowledge, starved for attention, and hungry to win a competition. What a wonderful opportunity to feed the hungry! Or to satisfy a child's curiosity to know more about Jesus! Or as a catechist to nourish your own spiritual appetite by deepening your faith! Like the Apostles, we are called to use our gifts and talents, however meager they seem to us, to serve others and build the Kingdom of God.

Becoming a catechist, catechist aide, or a volunteer with Religious Education is a way to satisfy your hunger for knowledge, build community, and pass on your faith to children. Presently, there is a need for catechists and catechist aides in some classes in grades 1-4 during the 3:15 - 4:30 p.m. and 5:15 - 6:30 p.m. sessions on Wednesday evenings.

Some of our RE sessions are filling up so make sure to register your children for classes. Our Opening Event for parents and children is Wednesday, September 10 from 6:30 - 7:30 p.m.

Top 10 Reasons to Become a Catechist...

- Kids say the darndest things that will surprise, delight, and sometimes shock you!
- 9. Relaxing at home on Wednesday evenings is so overrated.
- 8. God has been nudging you to get more involved in the Parish, so say yes to God!
- 7. The children are a captive audience for 1.5 hours each week ready to learn what you have carefully planned.

- 6. As a catechist you will have the Teacher Manual with MOST of the answers. For those times that you feel you don't have the answer, trust that God has the answer.
- 5. You have experienced God's goodness in your life and want to share this awareness with children.
- 4. You value the strong partnership between parents and catechists to build a strong foundation so the children become life-long Catholics.
- 3. The children will teach you as much as you teach them as you build up the Kingdom of God.
- 2. Everyone is called to be a "catechist"- one who echoes God's word so answer God's call!
- 1. All catechists are supported by Jo, the Director of Faith Formation, with helpful hints in faith formation, lesson planning, and classroom management.

It is edifying to see that some of our catechist aides are high school students! If you feel called to be a catechist that will interact with children or want to volunteer to help out in the classroom, call Jo at the Religious Education Office.


