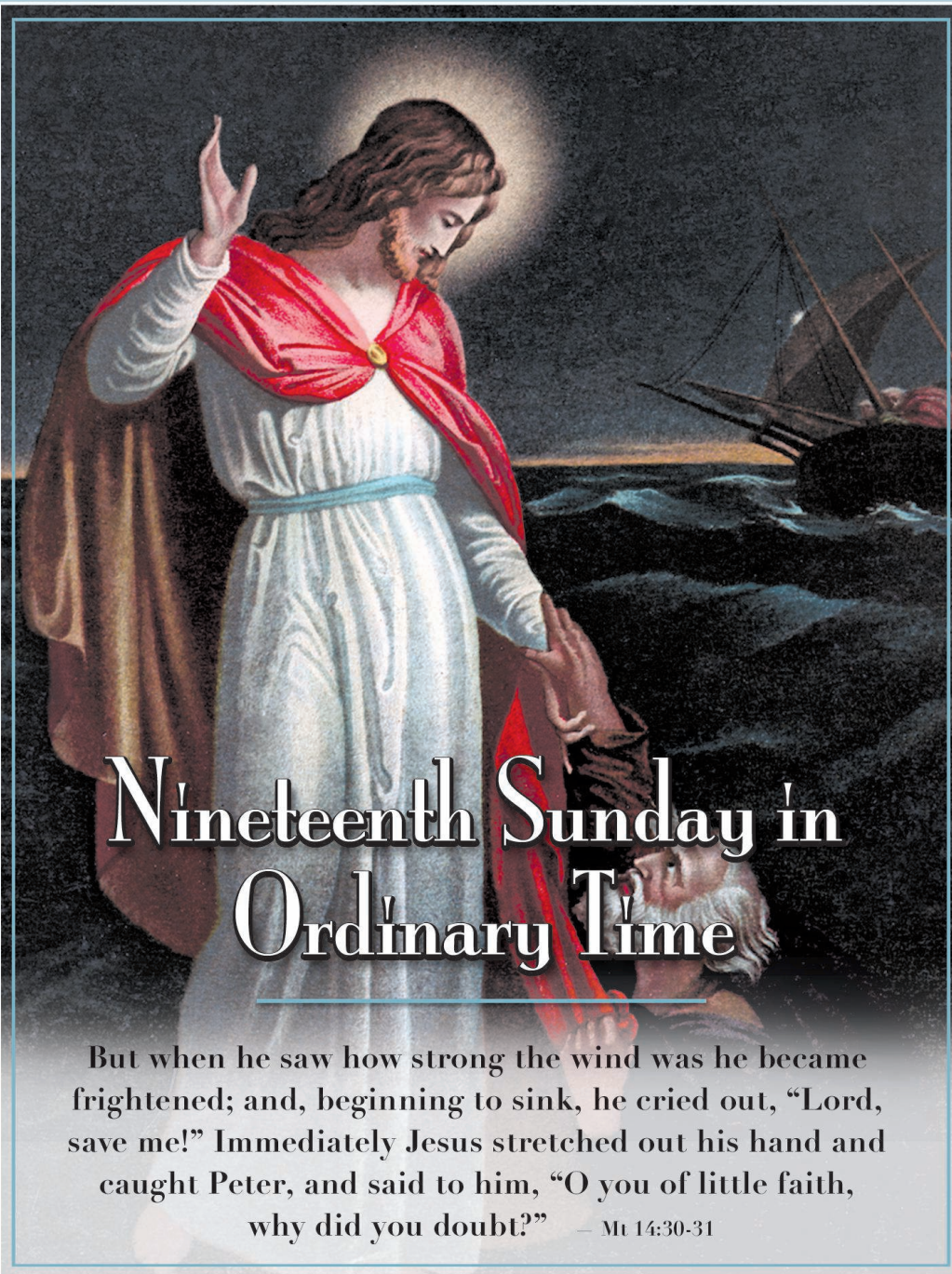

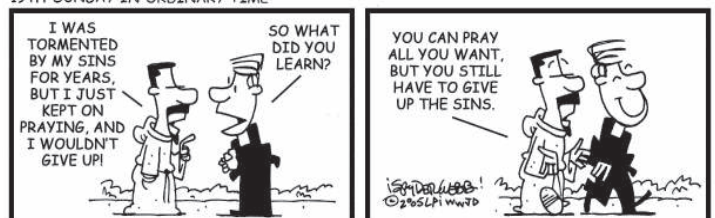
PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN TRAINING IN AUGUST AND SEPTEMBER
