- ◆ Held potluck and celebration for Sister Marybeth's 25th Jubilee and Sr. Anne's 15 year anniversary with the Servants of the Holy Heart of Mary
- ◆ Experienced friendship and fellowship with people of Hopkins Park
- ◆ We became closer as a group... became family

One of the quotes that touched our hearts this mission trip was said by a couple of the people from Hopkins Park.. "You have to feed the greedy to get to the needy"

We all came back different people from our time in Hopkins Park, following are some of the personal reflections of the students from MQH:

The most exciting part about this trip was meeting the people there. They wake up every morning feeling blessed even if they don't have a lot.

Hopkins Park and Sacred Heart Church is a great place to have fun, help people and grow in faith, all in a few days. We learned many life lessons here. I know something that changed me was helping out at the food pantry. All of the people there were welcoming and friendly. It was the opposite of what I

was expecting. When you are here you will find the unexpected and be changed.

Seeing everyone's smiling faces all day is definitely worth getting up early in the morning for. We gave out food at the food pantry and everyone was smiling all the time. You ask someone how they are and they say "I'm blessed."

This was my first time going to Hopkins Park and it was a little scary. This was a holy and different place. Despite the prejudices you may have, know that EVERYONE is God loving and accepting of others. If you give yourself over to Hopkins Park you will be surprised how you will change.

This place is extremely special and you recognize that you have done something that is amazing. You might think nothing special will happen, but it does.

Our mission trip to Hopkins Park has become an annual reminder of how to be thankful for all I have. Seeing the way the people of Hopkins Park have surrendered their lives to God's will reminds me of how "MULCH" more I can do with my daily relationship with God.... AMEN!

Hopkins Park is a great place to go for a weekend mission trip because it allows you to help others while helping yourself. You get to do God's work while "unplugging" from our world of consumerism and all of its material idols. Also, the true openness and love of God the community shares is very inspiring and beautiful. After this weekend I came to remember "I'm Blessed."

Hopkins Park; where the people are sweet and the land is sand. The first thing you should know is the people of this amazing town are very open in their faith. They are also very open as people. If you are introducing yourself, don't you dare give them a hand shake. They like hugs and you have to find a way to be open like them. You will see many sad things and many powerful things here if you let God lead you. They will change you for the better. The most important thing is that you WILL find God here, whether it's in the smile of someone you meet or in the sandy dirt. So let God lead and you will find heaven on earth here.

This is my third year coming and honestly I have a blast every year I come. We do so much and have such a great experience you don't want to leave.

The Hopkins Park trip helps you realize how nice you have it living in Elmhurst. It really opens your eyes because Elmhurst is a wealthy town and you don't really see poverty like you do in Hopkins Park.

The mission to Hopkins Park is truly life changing. The people I had the privilege to meet had so little physically, yet spiritually have it all. They have an amazing relationship with God, one like we should all have in our own lives no matter how much we have. I recommend this trip to anyone, no matter what their age.

Something I learned is to be helpful. There is always more work to be done, so don't be afraid to go above and beyond the call of duty. If something needs fixing or painting or mulching, all you need to do is ask and you start a new adventure.

Here in Hopkins Park there is an essential rule: the people are huggers so you better be ready to give lots of hugs. The people are like no other people you will meet. They are the most welcoming group of people I have ever met. Don't be afraid to sing out and worship out loud. You may think it a cliché to say that being here will change your life, but REALLY... this place will change your life! I know it has changed mine. Once you see and experience the level of appreciation for what the residents have (which is far less than any of us will ever have) it will change your life. They appreciate everything given to them in life. You learn to appreciate the life you have and the people in your life that love you and give so much to you. You learn to understand how much God can give you in life. Once you see what He has given to the people of Hopkins Park, pass it on!

In the two years I have gone to Hopkins Park I went back home a changed person. This year coming back I loved it even more. When I first decided to come I thought it was just going to be boring just doing outdoor work and after last year I realized how much more it was. Being a part of the food pantry and helping everybody out really made me realize what I

take for granted and that I should appreciate everything I have. The people here don't have expensive things, but are grateful for what they have and are never negative. They always have a smile on their face and they make my day. I can't wait for next year! It will change your life if you open your heart.


When we were told we would come back different people they were not kidding. There is no way you can experience Hopkins Park and not be changed for the better. God was certainly at work in our hearts and the hearts of the people there. ~ "I'm Blessed"

I come from a family where what I need or want, I have. Coming here showed me people don't always get what they want and most of all need. When we went to the food pantry I was worried the people would look at us like here come the city people with their amazing lives to help us, but honestly they were so happy to have us there to help. I love that I can be open with my religion and just let it all out. Hopkins Park gives me hope that the world is going to be okay. At home I think there are times we feel like we need to be who we think everyone else thinks we should be, but the people of Hopkins Park accept you for who you are. I learned that I can be the person I am called by God to be. Love ~ the child of God.

We all came back truly feeling God's love and grace... a very special thank you to all of our adult volunteers... watch for more news about our trip and plans to contribute more to the families of Hopkins Park.

Due to the Labor Day holiday, Eucharistic Adoration is scheduled for Monday, September 8.



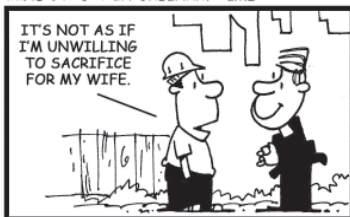
ALTAR SERVER TRAINING SESSION
