Note from the Pastor



This weekend the Church celebrates all of her members who dedicate themselves to the passing on of the faith Whether they as catechists. are professional teachers or volunteers, their

dedication and skill are invaluable in the life of the Church. Each of us owes some aspect of our faith to someone else who taught us about the Gospel.

Many Catholics have used the word "catechism" for years, and they know it has something to do with the compendium of the Church's teachings. The root word, "catechesis," is from a Greek word meaning "to echo, or resound." Catechesis is the act of resounding or bringing the Church's teachings to the world. A catechist is one who teaches in the name of the Church.

Many of us first heard the echo of the good news of the Gospel from our parents. Parents have just as much of a responsibility to echo the teachings of the faith to their children as do our dedicated Catechists. I have heard too many times the lament of the Catechist: "We can only do so much. If the teaching does not continue in the family, then our efforts often seem lost." Catechists cannot be the only person from whom your child hears about the faith. Faith cannot be taught, learned, or put into practice in a one hour class a week.

Let us pray this weekend for all who are called to echo the good news to future generations, in the classroom and in the family. The current generation of children will need the formation to be strong in their faith and tools to defend their beliefs against a culture that will challenge their faith.

May God bless all those who teach, those who take part in that grand echoing of the faith that has been resounding through the ages since that day the empty tomb was found.

Today we celebrate our catechists on this Catechetical Sunday! Every Baptized Catholic is called to catechize, or echo God's Word lived out in his or her life. Join me in thanking God for those men and women of our parish who volunteer their time to share their faith with our children.

This year's theme is God's Gift of Forgiveness. There is a familiar quote: "To err is human, to forgive, divine." Messing up is a part of being human. The Good News is that God is here to forgive our sins and restore us to wholeness. Learning to lean on God for forgiveness, getting squared with God, ourselves, and others is an ongoing process begun in the family. It is within the family that we learn that everyone makes mistakes and even sins, how to express sorrow for our hurtful actions, and our family helps us to patch things up together. 


