### Note from the Pastor



Today we celebrate World Mission Sunday and the Church is asking for your help to support her Missionary efforts throughout the world. It is unfortunate that the missionary role and identity of the Church tends to be forgotten in an area where the Church has become an established institution. It seems that gone are the days when young men and women are inspired by the stories of heroic missionary saints to dedicate their lives to traveling to areas where the Gospel has not been heard. Indeed, we may fall into the trap of believing that all corners of the earth have been evangelized and missionary work is a thing of the past or that because we do not have a direct role in the spread of the Gospel, we are not responsible for the salvation of anyone but ourselves. This year's Mission Sunday theme "I will build MY Church" (Mt 16:18) is a reminder that there is no our Church vs. their Church. We are all responsible to support the preaching of the Gospel in lands near and far away.

In his writings and addresses, Pope Francis has placed special emphasis on the need for the Church to recapture the spirit of mission. On World Mission Day, he said, "Many parts of the world are experiencing a dearth of vocations to the priesthood and the consecrated life. Often this is due to the absence of contagious apostolic fervour in communities which lack enthusiasm and thus fail to attract. The joy of the Gospel is born of the encounter with Christ and from sharing with the poor. For this reason I encourage parish communities, associations and groups to live an intense fraternal life, grounded in love for Jesus and concern for the needs of the most disadvantaged. Wherever there is joy, enthusiasm and a desire to bring Christ to others, genuine vocations arise. Among these vocations, we should not overlook lay vocations to mission. There has been a growing awareness of the identity and mission of the lay faithful in the Church, as well as a recognition that they are called to take an increasingly important role in the spread of the Gospel."

Please take some time today to pray about how God is calling you to participate in the missionary work of the Church. Certainly, support of the missions

who will benefit from this weekend's appeals is one way to participate in the missionary work of the Church. Other opportunities to spread the Gospel abound. In our increasingly secular country, they are all around us. For the Church to thrive, all need to see the preaching of the Gospel as a fundamental part of their Christian life.

Thank you for your generous response to the appeal and God's invitation to be a valuable member of His missionary team, spreading the good news of the Gospel to all those we meet,

## Eastern Dupage Deanery of the Diocese of Joliet

Greeting Fellow Disciples of Christ,

“The Catholic faith never changes, but the language and mode of manifesting this one faith can change according to peoples, times, and places.” Cardinal Francis Arinze, Cardinal-Bishop of Velletri-Segni has preached this message for decades. Today we find ourselves in the midst of change and are working to embrace this change in order to help us grow closer to God, to our Church and to our parishes. Bishop Conlon has asked that the deaneries throughout the Diocese create a steering committee to work together to strengthen our Catholic communities through collaboration. So, our steering committee was created. We are the Eastern DuPage Deanery of the Joliet Diocese, and we consist of 16 parishes in our ever growing family of God. Our steering committee includes Priests, Deacons, and parishioners and has come together with a mission to create a spirit of collaboration among our parishes to foster the building of the Kingdom of God.

The committee is working to find creative ways to grow our ministries and to generate excitement within them. By sharing our resources, we can relieve some of the stress on the people who serve in these ministries and reduce the risk that they become overextended. We begin to move forward by creating ties between the 16 parishes within our deanery. A Deanery Directory is the first tool being created for this purpose. This directory will be made available to all of us as deanery members. Additional tools are being developed that will facilitate the flow of this information. Our plan includes utilizing both old and new technologies so that everyone can access the information that they need.

Our steering committee is broken down into six subcommittees including communications, health care outreach, adult formation, sacramental preparation, social outreach, and liturgical events. We recently began holding monthly meetings that will continue through the next year. All are welcome to join us at these open meetings. Please feel free to come and share your ideas.

This process of greater collaboration is God’s project. As Bishop Conlon stated in his article, *Working Together*, in the January 2014 issue of *Christ is Our Hope* magazine, “The Church is an instrument in God’s hands, designed by Him to do His work. Thus, we must pray constantly about this effort and seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit.” Let us know what you would like to see happen within our deanery as well as what you can do to help us. We are all called as Catholics to be Priest, Prophet, and King to our brothers and sisters by our baptism. Please help the Eastern DuPage Deanery to live this promise by working on this effort together.
