Note from the Pastoral Associate



This weekend is packed with meaning for us as a Catholic Community. November 1 is All Saints Day. We have the saints as role models that encourage us not to give in or give up. With God in our lives, overcoming the foibles of the human condition is possible! Change is possible! Do you have a favorite saint? What about the name you were given at Baptism? What do you know about him or her? In today's web connected society a quick "google" search could tell you a lot about your saint.

My "go-to" saint is St. Martha. My mother first introduced me to St. Martha as a young child. As an adult I relate to her workaholic personality but realize I need to integrate more of her sister Mary's contemplative nature. My grandmother looked to St. Rita of Cascia as did many of my uncles. My Dad had a unique connection to Mother Cabrini. Back in the day it was popular to pray novenas requesting a saint to act as an intercessor for our needs. While novenas may not be used as frequently today, they are a form of prayer that has meaning to many who seek the help of a saint. It is important to note that all the Saints lead ultimately to Jesus. They all point towards God.

The other events this weekend are near and dear to my heart in my roles here at Mary Queen. At the 4:30 Mass this weekend the RCIA will celebrate the RITE OF WELCOME. If you are unfamiliar with this rite, it is a time when we will hear directly from people who are either seeking full communion in the Catholic Church or desire to complete the Sacraments of Initiation. Like all of our sacraments, this rite is rich with symbolic language that communicates our connection and need for God. There is the "signing of the senses" where the head, ears, mouth, heart, hands and feet are marked with the sign of the cross intended to remind both the recipient and the congregation that through our temporal bodies we will live our Baptismal commitment to serve God and neighbor.

On Sunday, November 2, we celebrate All Souls Day. A time when we remember the lives and gifts of our loved ones who have died. How can we say "celebrate" along side "death"? Because we are

Christians. Because Christians have the hope of eternal life promised to those who follow Christ. We Catholics love a good oxymoron! Celebrate death? Perhaps God wishes to turn our thinking upside down. Our thoughts are not God's thoughts, and our ways are not God's ways (Is. 55: 8). God always offers another step forward-even when we perceive a dead end.

Are you missing a loved one who has died? Think about this: every time you receive Holy Eucharist you are uniquely reconnected to that person. As we receive Jesus in a form that our earthly bodies can accept, our loved one is experiencing God in His totality! For that moment heaven and earth kiss!

So let us go forth strengthened by God's Word and His presence in the Eucharist to remember, celebrate, and serve!

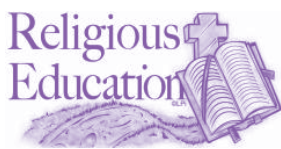
CHRIST RENEWS HIS PARISH (CRHP) WILL BE HERE BEFORE YOU KNOW IT MARK THE DATES NOW!!!
