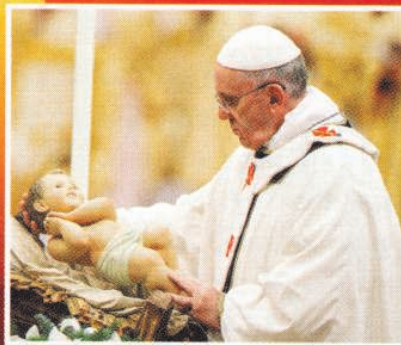

Note from the Pastor

Happy Advent! Can you believe that the time of Christmas preparation is already upon us? I think I start to sense the change coming when that section at the store turns from garden supply to back to school to candy. However, until Thanksgiving, it seems so far off, something else that will have to wait until the day when I have some time to prepare or until it cannot wait any longer.

It is probably no accident that our secular movement into the time we call Christmas involves weeks of mental preparation as we plan parties, gifts, and hope that the celebration of that one day in December lives up to our expectations. After all, the Church's celebration of Advent is all about waking up to the fact that Christ is coming, preparing for that day, and living in that sense of hope and expectation that is natural for a people waiting for a great day of joy to arrive.

Of course, the Church in Advent is helping us to realize not just that December 25th is coming, but that we are all approaching the coming of Jesus on the last day. Advent gives us a specific time to be reminded of that aspect of our lives. We should be preparing for that arrival every day. The business of life distracts us from that fact and can get even more in the way of realizing that we are not just preparing for a one day celebration of Jesus' birth, but the eternal celebration of his coming in glory.

I encourage you to be mindful of the spiritual preparation into which Advent calls you to enter, even as you are busy with decking the halls, gift buying and enjoying gatherings with family and friends. The reality is that Christmas 2014 will come and go. Consider how the time you spend in the next month will prepare you, not for Christmas, but for the days after? What will you be left with once the gifts are open, family has gone home, and the now brown pine needles must be picked up off the floor? Hopefully you will have something more to show for it than an empty bank account, overrun credit card, or pants that don't fit like they did in November.

In order to help you enter into this time of spiritual preparation, I encourage you to include a little Advent to help you stay mindful of the real reason

for the season. Advent wreaths will be available for purchase after the Masses. An Advent reflection book entitled, "Our Advent Journey with Christ" will be available for you to take home as well. Take some time, even if just a few minutes each evening, to light the Advent candles and take a short break from the holiday bustle to read, consider how Christ is preparing you, and discuss your journey or insights with family and friends. I guarantee it will help you to be prepared for whatever comes, whether it is the challenge of surviving the Christmas rush in the stores or enjoying some time with the peace of the celebration of God's arrival among us as the baby Jesus.

May God bless your Advent time of preparation, expectation, and celebration.
