Happy Church New Year 2015!  
The Church began a new year last Sunday, the First Sunday of Advent.

This year has been named the "Year of Consecrated Life" by Pope Francis. This theme is a pertinent and needed one, as awareness of the continued presence and contributions of those who have dedicated their lives to God in a consecrated vocation has dwindled. Indeed, gone are the days when teams of Religious Sisters and Brothers were found in the halls of any Catholic institution.

Even though religious are not as visible as they once were, they are certainly still around and working for the Church and even in the community. Our own Sister Marlene Geimer, who works in our office, is a member of the Sisters of the Living Word. Sister Mary Terese Giblin, a Franciscan Sister of Christ the King, leads the Catholic Campus Ministry at Elmhurst College. I have also worked with religious who teach and administrate schools, provide healthcare in hospitals, among other roles. And I would be remiss not to mention the religious priests who are being brought into our parishes to help address the shortage of diocesan priests.

We have been given the following prayer to pray in this year as we ask God to help those who are living consecrated lives and also to ask that he would open the hearts of our youth to consider their own possible call to consecrated life:

During this Year of Consecrated Life, we give you thanks for these courageous witnesses of Faith and models of inspiration. Their pursuit of holy lives teaches us to make a more perfect offering of ourselves to you. Continue to enrich your Church by calling forth sons and daughters who, having found the pearl of great price, treasure the Kingdom of Heaven above all things. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.

### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION



One of my favorite t- shirts had a message that read, "Jesus is coming..." and on the back side it read, "...look busy." Advent is a time to prepare for the coming of Christ into our lives, not to just "look busy." We can get busy about recognizing the presence of Christ in the poor and by generously giving to the Christmas Food Drive and the Marillac House Toy Drive. Setting a priority for prayer is another way to seek a deeper relationship with Jesus in our daily lives during Advent. Being more helpful at home and willing to pitch in to help others is another way to bring the Light of Christ into the world.

**A Family's Journey to Bethlehem-** While you set up the family Nativity scene, or crèche, start with the empty stable and the empty manger. Put the figures of Mary and Joseph with the donkey on the other side of the room, and move them closer to the stable each evening so that they "arrive" just before Christmas Eve. As the sun goes down on Christmas Eve, add the Baby Jesus to the manger with the angels and shepherd. Be sure not to add the Three Kings just yet- they are still on their way.
