Note from the Pastor



Happy Feast of the Holy Family! Today we continue our celebration of the Christmas season by reflecting on the life of the Holy Family of Nazareth. Not much is known of that time between Jesus

as a baby in the manger and His baptism. Scripture tells us of the flight to Egypt, the finding in the temple, and that Jesus spent His childhood in Nazareth. Just as on Christmas night we pondered the scene of the baby in Bethlehem, now in these days of Christmas we ponder what the scene of Jesus' childhood was like. Imagine His days. Were they filled with play, learning, work? What was His relationship and responsibilities to His mother and father? Extended family?



Family life was probably fairly different in Jesus' time than in our own. Families stayed in one place. Often multiple generations lived under one roof. Villages were often just one large extended family unit. That probably had advantages, but I am sure it had disadvantages also. As mobile and separated as our extended families are these days, I have a difficult time imagining what such a large family existence would be like. What is your family existence like? What are your relationships and responsibilities to relatives close and far? Family life has its blessings but also its challenges. We did not get to choose the members of our families or how our family history would shape our lives. God blessed us with families and through them, both in love and in struggles to love, we work out who we are and what our relationship and responsibilities to the larger world family that we belong to will be.

As we approach the New Year and spend this time considering family life, consider some family related New Year's resolutions. Are there ways you could be more connected to, or supportive of, your family? Are there wounds that need to be healed or family members with whom you have lost touch? Now is a good time to resolve to make some renewed effort at family life. After all, unlike that gym membership that no one will notice after February, being part of a family is a membership that is truly tragic if ignored or let go to waste.


