

Note from the Pastor



Happy New Year! As we enter into this new year, we are all looking ahead in hope with resolutions and goals for the coming year. That makes this a good time to share with you some of my goals for improving our facilities. We are

blessed with a beautiful campus and one thing that is a rarity in many parishes: ample available space. After consulting with staff, parish council, and finance council, I have identified some areas that will need work in the coming year so that we can use and enjoy our space more comfortably and efficiently.

Our parish offices are spread out between two different buildings and in three different areas. We have outgrown the available office space in the rectory and it is not handicapped accessible. One office is in the basement with substandard ventilation and emergency exit. Four employees are sharing two desks in the front office. To improve working conditions and accessibility, I am seeking to move the offices from the rectory into the offices in the front of the school and the current library/conference rooms in Mary's Gathering Space. A new reception area will be created in the northeast corner of Mary's Gathering Space. As part of this effort, I am also exploring the possibility of installing a door half way down the school hallway to divide the preschool from the rest of the school building, such that the first three or four classrooms would become available for use as conference rooms for meetings and/ or activities.

In both the church and school buildings, the windows are all original and are well past the end of their useful life. Many windows are being held shut this winter by duct tape as they no longer remain closed on their own. In our preschool classrooms and sacristy, we have resorted to the use of cellophane covering to seal the windows for the winter. New windows will be a major expenditure. However, we cannot continue to put off their replacement. Although it is hard to know for sure how much, we estimate hundreds of dollars of heating is going out our windows every month. Replacing the school windows will also force us to install a new climate control system in the school. The upside is that both new windows and climate control will be more energy efficient than our current setup and should result in cost savings as well as benefitting the environment.

Finally, I am aware that the pews in the Church are

worn and tired and their cushioning is deflated. I will be exploring options for their refinishing or replacement.

As we all share this campus with which we have been blessed, I welcome your input, suggestions, and ideas. Please mail or email suggestions to the parish office. (parishoffice@maryqueen.org) by January 31st. I will continue to keep you up to date on these projects as they move forward.

May God bless our Mary Queen parish family in 2015!




