

Christ is risen! Alleluia! He is truly risen! Alleluia!

The above Paschal Greeting has been used since the early days of Christianity.

It is a greeting we should use with each other on this joy filled day, since it concisely presents the reason for our joy. It is the statement upon which our faith is founded: Jesus could not be contained even by death itself.

What peace that should bring us! What joy we should feel in knowing that God has not left us to perish after this life, but has come to die our death so as to show us the way to new life! 



#### JOLIET DIOCESE VOCATION OFFICE JEREMIAH DAY SEMINARY TRIP PARENTAL PERMISSION FORM
