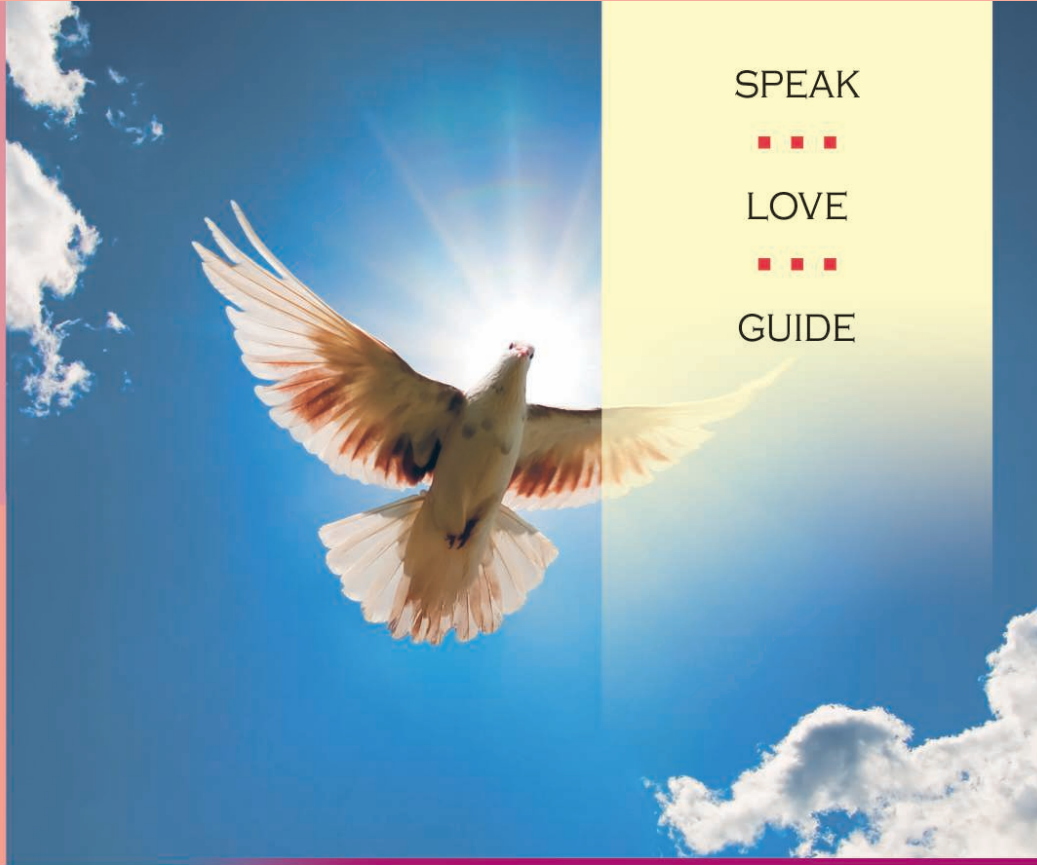

A Note from Father Jason

Today we celebrate the feast of Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples. They spoke words they did not understand underneath those tongues of the fire of the spirit. After that day, they were united together in the work of spreading the Good News and the Church was born.

This weekend is also Memorial Day weekend. When you speak to men and women who have served in the armed forces, one of the things that they often value about their service is the camaraderie that they shared. Those who have been in combat talk about the trust they place in fellow members of their unit, and how important it is to them that they know that someone has always got their back. When that trust breaks down, when another soldier doesn't think that he or she can count on someone else, the ability of the unit to get the job done is at risk. Commanding officers recognize the importance of unit cohesion, as they call it, and part of regular training is to develop and maintain that spirit among those who serve. That spirit, that sense of camaraderie, is always something that many members of the service say they miss when they return to civilian life.

On Pentecost we celebrate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the disciples, and upon us! The Spirit energizes us for our work in the world of spreading the good news of Christ. As Jesus tells us in today's Gospel, we will testify because we have been given the Spirit of truth that proceeds from the Father.


The gift of the Holy Spirit is what develops our "unit cohesion" as the body of Christ in this world and particularly as the Church community of Mary Queen of Heaven. The Spirit unites us also with other Christians throughout the world so that we can complete our mission of continuing the work that the disciples began: spreading the Good News.

May God bless you this weekend as you remember those who sacrificed for our great nation. In some way, the Spirit of Pentecost was behind their sacrifice. The Spirit is calling and moving your heart right now. It may not be to such an extreme sacrifice, it may not be to travel abroad as a missionary, but the Spirit is definitely calling you to witness to the

Good News in some way or another. He has already moved you to be a part of this Mary Queen of Heaven community! Open your hearts to discern how He is calling and moving you to become more deeply connected to this community and to take the Spirit with you, wherever life takes you.

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful!

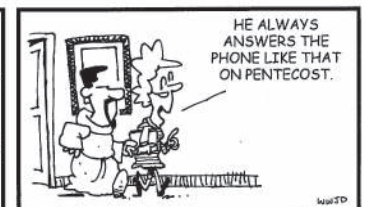


WORLDWIDE MARRIAGE ENCOUNTER

and hunker down with a great read.

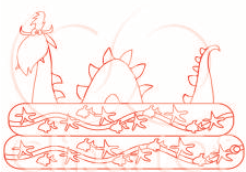
A great book makes one think, and a great book club encourages sharing ideas about the
