A Note from Seminarian Christian

My name is Christian Martin Padilla. I was born on August 20, 1989 in the city of Tepatlán in the state of Jalisco in Mexico. I am number twelve in a family of fourteen children, in which I have nine sisters and four brothers. When I was eleven months old, I had a major health problem and was hospitalized for pneumonia. Everything got complicated since I was also diagnosed with a heart murmur and an enlarged liver. Doctors operated on me but there was very little hope of life for me. It was then, when



God decided to intervene giving my health back, allowing me to live. In order to fulfill a promise my mother made to get my health back, I was dressed as Saint Martin de Porres for five years. Every day and every hour of those five years, I wore the old habit of the Dominican lay brother, a black **scapular** and **capuce**.

The first nine years of my life I lived in a rural community and then returned to the city. Shortly after we arrived to the city we went to Mass. The priest invited us children to serve at the altar, and I along with another friend joined the group of altar servers. Right there began my love for the Eucharist. While being an altar server, the call from God to serve him started but I did not pay attention to the voice of God and refused to respond. When the priest invited me to attend the pre-seminary or life of seminarians, I said no, no, no. How am I going to leave my friends, my money and my family? I even joked around when people or my parents would talk to me about going to the seminary.

When I was thirteen my mom had problems with her back and underwent surgery. I stayed home to help since she could not do anything. During this year I did not attend school, but I learned many other things such as cooking, washing and ironing but especially I learned to dialogue with God. By then, the call from God began to resound in my ears and in my heart, becoming a meteor shower, where you first see one star and then others appear behind it. That's how I discovered the call from God because it started with the Father and then through the people. Such was the insistence of God through the people that I said "okay, I'll try." I remember when I told my

family about going to the seminary, not all of them agreed. My dad and some of my siblings told me flatly that it was not a good idea but my mom and the rest of my siblings told me they would support me and they did. In 2005 I decided to experience the seminary. This was when I was 15 and in the Diocese of San Juan de los Lagos. I stayed eight years in the seminary during middle school and high school.

When I was studying philosophy, a priest of the Diocese of Sacramento in California came to visit the seminary. As he had no permission from the bishop to promote vocations, he only talked to a few of us about the reality of vocations in the United States and the need for his diocese. I felt like something moved inside me. Later, Father Burke Master came to visit the diocese. He talked to us about the story of his vocation and about the opportunity of coming to the Diocese of Joliet. Thirty four companions went to interview with Father Burke but the interesting thing is that the Diocese of Joliet chose only five of the thirty-five, and by God's grace I was invited to come and visit the Diocese of Joliet. When visiting the Diocese of Joliet I saw two things that struck me. First was the need and thirst for God in this diocese and the need to have somebody to guide them to meet the God that loves us and second, the need to take care of the Latino people as well as other communities in this diocese. After coming to this diocese, I returned for a year of discernment in the Seminary of San Juan de los Lagos in Mexico and by the grace of God I decided to accept the invitation to come here to the Diocese of Joliet to live this adventure of love. I am here with joy and happiness, putting my life in God's hands to follow the path that He wants and to do His will.

and hunker down with a great read.

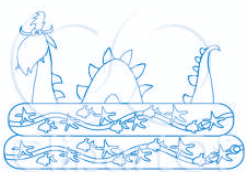
A great book makes one think, and a great book club encourages sharing ideas about the book. Perhaps you will even explore your own life stories about why you stay Catholic.


