

A Note from Father Jason

For centuries, blood has been perceived as the life force in humans. For most of us, the complexity of what blood does

as it courses through our bodies is lost to most of us. Our bodies need blood. But we can willingly part with some blood with little consequence to our health (aside from maybe a brief feeling of wooziness) when we donate blood to a local blood bank.

In His death on the cross, Christ made the ultimate donation of blood. He shed His blood and gave His life for our salvation. When Jesus hands the cup to His disciples at the Last Supper, He says to them, "This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many" (Mk 14:24). These words of the Lord are repeated at every Mass, reminding us that it is more than wine in the chalice we take up, and more than bread in the host we consume.

As we celebrate this solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, and the deep mystery that exists in that sacrament of Christ's gift to us, we realize that we are weak human beings as we stand before the power of God. In receiving the Body and Blood of Christ we are renewed, nourished, and healed. Like a blood transfusion for an ailing individual, the sacrament of Christ's body and blood gives us strength for our daily lives. Fortified by Christ, we can no longer be anemic in our faith. Rather, with the full vigor that comes from regularly sharing in the Eucharist we live out our lives as Christians.

Corpus Christi is a good time for a few reminders about receiving the Eucharist:

- Only Catholics who are properly disposed to receive the sacrament should receive communion. This means that one has confessed any serious sins and fasted for one hour before receiving the sacrament.
- When one approaches the minister, he or she should place one hand over the other until the host is placed on the hand. The hand beneath is then used to pick up the host and place it in the mouth.
- It has been brought to my attention that parishioners are walking away without consuming the host. It is a serious sin to do anything with the

Eucharist other than to place it in your mouth immediately. Eucharistic Ministers can and should stop those who do not consume the host.

- It is not permitted for a communicant to take the host to a minister of the cup and dip the host in the precious blood.
- One wishing to receive on the tongue should open their mouth wide enough for the host to be dropped in with the tongue extended only slightly. Please hold still until the host is on your tongue to prevent contact with the minister's hand.
- Ministers say "The Body of Christ" or "The Blood of Christ" and the communicant responds "Amen."
- Personal Pyxes may not be placed on the altar or in the bowl to be brought up to the altar, unless you have been given permission to do so by Fr. Jason or the priest celebrating the Mass. If you have a special dietary or other concern about the Eucharist or know someone who needs Eucharist brought to the homebound, please see Fr. Jason, Deacon Tom, or Deacon Alex.

May the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ, keep us all safe for eternal life,


