

I Feel Called to Be a Catechist...

Maybe being a catechist is something you feel God is calling you to, but you've got some reservations.

""...I don't know if I can handle a group of kids. I am not a teacher."

Every teacher or catechist gets nervous at the beginning of the year when meeting their class for the first time, even the kids. As the Director of Faith Formation, I want you to succeed! experienced teacher, I can give you tips on classroom management so that the kids in your class will know what behavior is expected. Setting up a routine will help the kids to know how the time and lesson will proceed. In the words of St. Francis de Sales, "Be yourself, and be that well." That is, be your best self: kind, patient, considerate, and prepared, the kids will be drawn to the person of Christ within you. Find Jesus in each person you interact with and you will radiate the love of Christ. You will have support, encouragement and help along the way.

"...I don't know if I'll be able to answer kids' auestions."

Being a catechist does not mean that you have all of the answers. Children can often be profound in their search for understanding God and such. Be honest. You could say,"That is a great question, what do you think?" or "I am going to have to look that up for us." And realize that some questions that children ask do not have an answer, and that is ok to tell them too.

As you yourself, learn more about the Catholic faith, you will grow in confidence as you face these stumpers. The Holy Spirit is a wonderful source of inspiration along the way. It's ok not to know, but knowing where to find the answer is the key.


