## *A Note from Father Jason*

In the Gospel this weekend, we hear the story of Jairus' daughter, who is near death and how Jesus heals her and brings her back into life, including the touching detail that they should be sure to give her something to eat. There are several gospel stories where Jesus heals one who is sick. The healing usually has multiple dimensions, not just stopping with being freed from illness, but also being restored to status in the community and being cared for by others.

Care of the sick is an important part of the life of the Church. Visiting the sick is a corporal work of mercy. In the past, it was much more a given that the sick would be cared for by family and friends and not left in isolation. All too often now, as we have become more accustomed to entrusting care of our loved ones who are ill to healthcare professionals and as family moves farther away from each other, I end up at visiting patients who have no one to visit because family lives so far away. As such, there is a greater need for those who can minister to the sick, whether in a simple way like visiting or participating in a service project for residents of a nursing home or the homebound, or more directly hearing Jesus' call to ensure the sick are fed by volunteering to distribute the Eucharist at the hospital, nursing home, or in their home.

At Mary Queen of Heaven, caring for our sick parishioners is an important part of our parish life. We have ministers that will visit and bring Eucharist to the sick. There is a whole team of volunteers that visit sick patients at Elmhurst Hospital. Many local priests are on a rotation to ensure that patients receive the sacrament of the sick.

Unfortunately, privacy laws have made it more difficult to know who is in the hospital. In addition, we are not always able to catch if someone has been away on Sundays due to extended illnesses. As a result, if you would like a visit, you need to let the parish know. It can be as simple as a phone call to the office or by communicating to a nurse or chaplain that you would like your parish to be notified that you are sick and would like your Church to be notified.

Also, please do not wait until it is almost too late to call for the anointing of the sick. The anointing is not considered a last rite, although sometimes it may be. It should be received any time one is seriously ill or about to undergo surgery. That means it should be requested when someone first arrives at the hospital, not after the doctors have ceased efforts. There are fewer priests and that means that there is no guarantee that one will be available between the time an unexpected code blue is called and it is too late.

God willing, neither you nor I will have to face such an illness any time soon. There is no escaping the fact that we will face it eventually. When you do, do not forget that your parish community is ready to serve and ensure that you are not separated from the sacraments as a result of your illness.

May God bless you with good health and move you to pray and care for the sick,

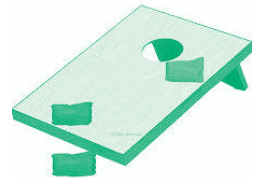
