PASTOR'S CORNER

In this weekend's Gospel, the followers of Jesus ask, "what can we do to accomplish the works of God?" and Jesus responds, "This is the work of God, that you believe in the one He sent." If Jesus says our work is in believing, is He saying that faith is enough and no further work on our part is needed? He almost certainly is not, but there has been considerable tension and debate between Catholics and Protestants over this matter. It is no small question, and certainly one to reflect on: Am I better off spending this moment in prayer or in works of service?

The work of a disciple is to believe in the one He sent... Jesus. That seems like an easy task. After all we can just say we believe and then all is good, right? Except that words are just words unless they are backed up by some concrete act that backs them up. For example, a husband can tell his wife that he loves her. She can then challenge him to prove it. He might then buy her a gift, do something nice for her, and live in such a way that shows he means what he says. The works then back up the words.

The real danger in considering this question is remembering that we do not have to earn our salvation through faith or works. Jesus already earned it for us on the cross. Our work is to open our hearts to accept that great gift by expressing our faith with the words of prayer and the works of charity that naturally flow from entering into the gift of mercy that has been given to us.

It is probably a good thing that we do not have to pile up a resume of prayers or service projects in order to receive salvation. After all, only few have the chance to dedicate their lives, let alone parts of it to either works of faith or of charity. Each of us has the opportunity to express our faith through the work we do every day, whether at school, work, or in family life. In saying our work is belief, Jesus is not saying choose work or faith, but express your faith in your work. Whatever work God gives you, be faithful, open with others about your faith, and witness where you find the opportunity. In doing so, you will be entering more deeply into those words "I believe" and growing into the great gift of forgiveness that was already worked for you on the cross.

Saint Joseph the worker, pray for us.






