

PASTOR'S CORNER



Happy Labor Day! This weekend's Gospel provides us with a fruitful meditation on the work that our Lord does and our call to put the effects of that work into action. In this Gospel, Jesus heals the deaf man by touching his ears and tongue and saying "Be Opened!" Unable to keep this miracle to himself, the healed man and those who witnessed his healing go forth to proclaim God's goodness.

Each of us was brought into the same healing by which our hearts were opened and each of us has been called to go forth and proclaim the goodness of God on the day of our baptism. At every baptism the celebrant touches the ears and lips of the one being baptized and proclaims, "May the Lord open your ears to hear His word and your lips to proclaim His praise, to the glory of God the father." The Lord has done the work of healing and now we are called to participate in the work of salvation by sharing that fact with others, proclaiming God's praise and giving Him the glory for our successes, which were only possible with His grace.

As we seek the Lord's help and blessing upon our labors, whether we are working to evangelize our neighbor by witnessing to the goodness of God or if we are witnessing by being faithful and hard working as we perform the labor to which we have been called, let us always seek the Lord's help. Psalm 90 is a good refrain to have in your mind as you begin a work day: "Give success to the work of my hands, Lord. Give success to the work of my hands."

St. Joseph the Worker is the Patron Saint of all those who Labor. I encourage you to pray for his help in obtaining the Lord's blessing upon your labors:

O God,

You asked St. Joseph to accept your will that his wife-to-be would have a Son.
St. Joseph accepted your will and worked with Jesus as His father and teacher.
We seek your blessing upon all the work of our hands,
and we dedicate our work to your greater glory.
We ask your blessing upon all workers,
especially those who work to make our lives easier and more enjoyable.
We ask all this through the intercession of St. Joseph,
patron saint of workers, in the name of Jesus your Son, in the unity of Holy Spirit.
Amen.






