

PASTOR'S CORNER

Back in my more youthful and adventurous days, I always loved a good adrenaline rush. However, I remember that whether I was jumping off a diving board into the pool, or catapulting myself down an icy ski hill identified with black diamonds, that I never wanted to be the first one to take the risk. There was always something about seeing someone else take the plunge before me that put me at ease and helped me say to myself, "I can do this without too many bruises."

In the gospel this weekend, we hear the teaching of Jesus that still guides our way as Christians through our spiritual lives: "Deny yourself, take up your cross, and follow Me." It is easy to get caught up on the first two parts of the exhortation: denying ourselves and taking up our crosses. The idea that we have to give anything up or carry a cross can seem to make the spiritual life unattractive or even frightening, as if a life of discipleship means only pain and suffering.

Do not miss the last part of the saying: follow Me. It is Jesus' way of assuring us that yes there will be sacrifices, yes the cross will be heavy at times, but you can do this without too many bruises. "Look," He says, "I have walked this road before you. I lived your life, struggled with many of the same things you do, and faced the end of the road just like you will someday. You should not fear your cross, for I picked the cross up first and I continue to carry it with you and for you."


My brothers and sisters, let us never forget that although we are called to deny, carry, and follow, we never do so alone. Jesus already took the plunge to show us that it can be done and He beckons us to follow Him. We are never alone as long as we follow His lead. He will show us the way, because He is THE way.

PRAYER SHAWL MINISTRY MEETING THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 17


