PASTOR'S CORNER



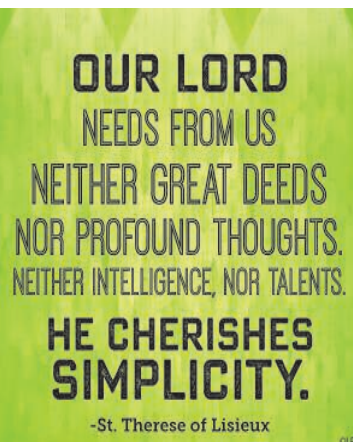
“Would that all the people of the Lord were prophets! Would that the Lord might bestow his spirit on them all!” (Numbers 11:29). Deep down in our heart, I bet you wish that you could look at everyone in your life and see the spirit at work in their lives and see how the example of their lives speaks prophetically to you. Chances are, that is not what you see. Human nature keeps us from seeing the Spirit at work in others, much less being open to hearing what they have to teach us. Instead, all too often we see only the sins of others, the mistakes they have made, or the hurt they have caused.

Our judgments can easily lead to a “Who’s in? Who’s out?” mentality. In this week’s Gospel, the disciples ask Jesus what to do about another group that is preaching and driving out demon’s in Jesus’ name, even though they are not in the group with Jesus Himself. Jesus responds by encouraging them to look beyond the group mentality and see the Spirit at work. Ancient monastic wisdom teaches that the best way to combat our judgmental tendencies is by always looking for the best possible interpretation of what others are doing. Perhaps a simpler way of saying this is to give others the benefit of the doubt.

It is unfortunate that in today’s world, the Church suffers from divisions that have been passed on to us over centuries. In many cases, what started as a small dispute has over time resulted in divisions so deep that it is not likely we will see common ground found in our lifetimes.

Let us commit ourselves to always seeking and praying for unity, not just between denominations, not just between parishes, but even within our parish itself. There is a very real risk of creating a small fracture that can become a larger division whenever believers stop working together and begin seeking to protect the interest of “their group.” Let us resolve to always seek to see the Spirit at work, even in other groups. Of course, that will not remove divisions and we will likely not change the hearts of those who have chosen to live without the Gospel, but we can strive to live a unity that prophetically proclaims the unifying goodness of God in which our faith is grounded.

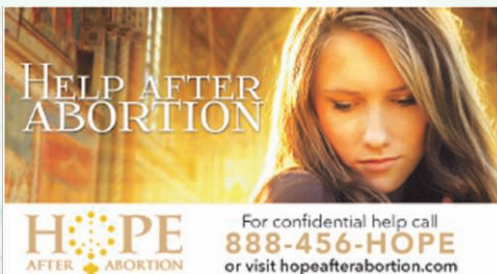
FOOD COLLECTION SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 26 AND SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 27
