PASTOR'S CORNER

In the Gospel this weekend, we hear the story of James and John and their attempts to strike a deal with Jesus to be given the power of sitting at His right hand in the Kingdom. We know that they did achieve a place of honor in the kingdom among the martyrs, but it was only by rising to the challenge of preaching the Gospel and drinking the cup of suffering from which Jesus drank by which they became the kind of servants by which one is admitted to a privileged place in the Kingdom.

Unfortunately, there is a challenging lesson in this teaching for us. One cannot make deals with God in order to enter heaven. One cannot buy our way into heaven by checking boxes off on a spiritual checklist. One cannot expect to take an easy road through life and be rewarded with VIP seats to the eternal feast of heaven. Instead, we are each given a call, a cup from which we must drink, a challenge to which we must rise, a battle which we must fight, a cross which must be carried.

Although all disciples are placed within this reality, men in a special way are called to rise to the challenge of fatherhood. Fatherhood is a challenging role, in which a man must rise to the call of not just providing for his family, but to defend his family from that which would harm it. He will have to be the one to stand in the breach and engage in a battle to provide, to lead his family toward that which is good, and to defend his family from all that which would harm the goodness of love upon which his family is founded.

An excellent reflection has just been written for our men to read, reflect upon, and to put into action in their lives. I encourage all of the men of Mary Queen of Heaven to spend some time with this document. It is the best exhortation to manhood that I have read in some time and is certainly pertinent for all of us as we rise to the challenge of Fatherhood. The document is entitled "INTO THE BREACH: An Apostolic Exhortation to Catholic Men, my Spiritual Sons" written by Bishop Thomas Olmsted, the Bishop of Phoenix. It is easy to find online. Simply use your favorite internet device to take you to <http://www.intothebreach.net>. It even has a theatrical trailer video to help get you pumped up.

The exhortation begins as a call to all men: "Men, do not hesitate to engage in the battle that is raging around you, the battle that is wounding our children and families, the battle that is distorting the dignity of both women and men. This battle is often hidden, but the battle is real. It is primarily spiritual, but it is progressively killing the remaining Christian ethos in our society and culture, and even in our own homes." The Bishop then addresses three questions: "What does it mean to be a Catholic man? How does a Catholic man love?" and "Why is fatherhood, fully understood, so crucial for every man?" These are all good questions to reflect upon and I encourage everyone, whether you are a father or someday will be one to take some time to consider how your life is answering these questions and/or how you can step into the breach in a more concrete way for the good of your family.

May Saint Joseph, patron of all fathers, intercede and assist all men in rising to the call and challenge of the discipleship of fatherhood,

Dear Family of Mary Queen,

Right now I feel a little like the hypochondriac who had written on his tombstone, "I told you I was sick." Well, I am (no surprise to many of you).

A few years back while preaching at Mary Queen, a wonderful cardiologist came up to me after Mass and asked, "What's wrong?" (Ever read the book "Blink"?) Turns out, I was in intermittent a-fib (atrial fibrillation). A visit to his brother, a local doc, a little bit of meds and I was fine... for a year and a half.

Three weeks ago I found myself at Central DuPage Hospital and then at St. Mary Hospital in Kankakee and then finally back home. Turns out, I need to have a valve job. The mitral-valve is leaking causing a prolapse (more medical knowledge than I ever wanted to know) and has been or will be replaced by the time you read this.

I have been overwhelmed by the kindness of former parishioners from all my parishes. In Kankakee, I had 12 visitors one morning. That's being, I'm afraid, over loved. What I seek from you are your prayers. When you're sick you truly feel the power of those praying for you. It's the greatest power in the world. So, no visits, lots of prayers.

I made a deal with the Lord: You want me to work? Get me well. God knows you don't have a lot of laborers for the vineyard.

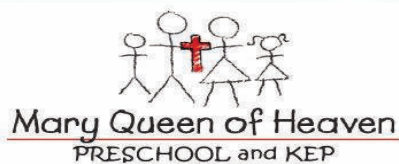

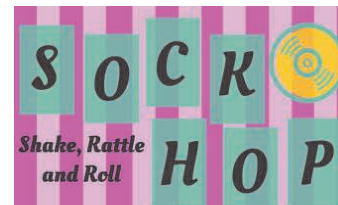
ALL SOUL'S DAY MONDAY, NOVEMBER 2

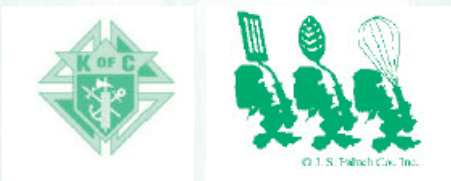

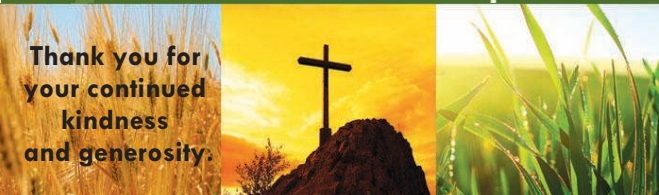
