PASTOR'S CORNER

This week we celebrate the two "All" feast days. These are not just the days when we celebrate that "I got ALL the chocolate trick or treating." I would warn against treating these as the days on which you eat all of your Halloween candy as well.

The All feasts are All Saints day on November 1st and All Souls day on November 2nd. All Saints day is the celebration for all of those whose lives witness to the holiness that they lived.

Although we celebrate many of the Saints by name throughout the year, on All Saints, we celebrate all of the saints, both those whose names we know and those whose heroic acts of holiness are known only to them and God. All Souls day is a day to remember all of our beloved family and friends and to pray for them. In addition to the morning Mass, a special Mass will be offered for those from our parish family who entered eternal life this past year at 7:00pm on November 2nd.

One of the great treasures of the Church is the writings of the Saints. On All Saints day, the Beatitudes are read. Here are some short reflections from the saints on the beatitudes which they lived: Blessed are:

- ... the poor in spirit: "Not even God can put anything in a heart that is already full" --Blessed Teresa of Calcutta.
- ... they who mourn: "They who weep for their own sins are blessed" --St. Thomas Aquinas.
- ... the meek: "There is nothing as strong as true meekness; there is nothing as gentle as true strength" --St. Francis de Sales.
- ... they who hunger and thirst for righteousness: "First of all, we must be just towards God. Let this fact be firmly impressed in our hearts, so that it shows in our behavior, for it is the touchstone of the true 'hunger and thirst for justice'" --St. Josemaría Escrivá.
- ... the merciful: "If a soul does not exercise mercy in one way or another, it will not obtain [Christ's] mercy on the Day of Judgment" --St. Faustina Kowalska.
- ... the clean of heart: "The pure soul is a beautiful rose, and the Three Divine Persons descend from Heaven to inhale its fragrance" -- St. John Vianney.
- ... the peacemakers: "Peace is not just the absence of war ... Like a cathedral, peace must be constructed patiently and with unshakable faith" --St. John Paul II.
- ... they who are persecuted for the sake of righteousness: "This is the teaching of Jesus Christ in the Gospel. How, then, can it be said, that those believe in the Gospel who say: 'Blessed are those who have money; blessed are those who suffer nothing ... pitiable is the man that suffers persecution and ill-treatment from others'? ... Either they do not believe the Gospel, or ... they believe only a part of it" --St. Alphonsus Liguori.

May you be blessed on these "days of All" by the intercession and help of all the saints and all of the souls of those you loved who now enjoy the presence of God. May you know their help and intercession, every time you ask their help in prayer.


