A NOTE FROM FATHER JASON

In the Gospel of this weekend, we hear the familiar Advent cry of Saint John the Baptist, "Prepare the way of the Lord!" For several weeks now, you have heard the cries of Father Jason proclaiming, "Prepare the way for the Bishop!" By the time you read this, he will be here.

We are blessed to have him with us and it is a testimony to his interest in the life of the parishes of the diocese that he is investing the time to visit each one. For many years, I knew the bishop only by the name prayed in the Eucharistic Prayer.

This weekend we have a chance to get to know the man behind the name. Please take some time to say hello and to visit with him. Doing so will help make this a fruitful time as he will get to know the friendly and welcoming people who make up our parish. In essence, it is an opportunity for us to help him to know us by more than our parish's name.

This Tuesday is the arrival of an event that has been also proclaimed in the wilderness for some time now, the Year of Mercy. Pope Francis has declared the time between December 8, 2015 and November 20, 2016 as an Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy. The goal which he has set forth for us is to make extra effort during this time to grow in our understanding of the role of God's mercy in our lives and by doing so to grow in our ability to witness to the world the great gift that mercy is to each of us, our parish communities, and the Church universal.

There are many ways to enter into this blessed year and grow in understanding and witness to mercy. First and foremost, blowing the dust off your Catechism and re-learning the Corporal and Spiritual works of mercy is a good start. Considering your participation in each work and praying for ways to engage more concretely in each work would be a good next step. More information can be found by using your favorite internet search engine to look up the pages for "usccb.org year of mercy" and "dioceseofjoliet.org year of mercy." You will find many resources to guide your learning, prayer, and works of mercy. The publishers of the *Magnificat* Missal have also published a "Year of Mercy Companion" that has reflections for each day of the holy year, along with other readings and resources.

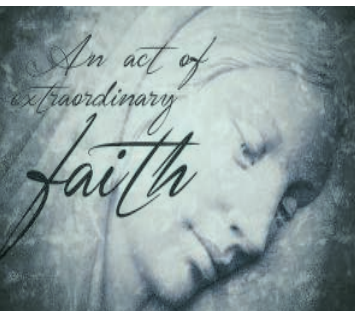
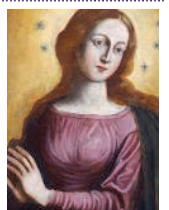
May God bless Bishop Daniel Conlon during his visit and may each of you be blessed with a profound experience of God's mercy during this Holy Year,
