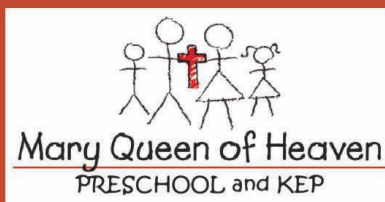

A NOTE FROM FATHER JASON

Through the prophet Jeremiah, we hear the word of God: "Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you, before you were born I dedicated you, a prophet to the nations I appointed you." What a powerful thought... God knew, dedicated, and appointed you before you even drew your first breath. God knows and He has chosen you by his grace to grow into a calling given by Him.

Perhaps yours is not to be a prophet to the nations (but never rule it out... God is full of surprises). However, you are called to be a prophet to someone, to grow into the gifts and virtues, especially the virtue of the love that never fails of which Paul speaks. Somehow, in ways we will only know on the last day, our lives then help fulfill God's plan to save humankind from destruction and lead us to our eternal home with Him.

In the Gospel, we hear how Jesus' proclamation brings division and even results in the people trying to drive Him away. Unfortunately, even in our day the work of bringing God's salvation to fulfillment is just as challenging as and certainly no more popular than in Jesus' lifetime. And yet, we are called by God's grace to work to build up the kingdom today. The call and grace is not a once spoken command, but an ongoing way that we live out our relationship with God.

We do not have to respond alone. God made us creatures of community and communion, a connection we find most concretely manifest in the Catholic Church. Since Jesus' day, the Church has been gathered by God to work out the salvation of the world against each generation's challenges and to do so by caring for the poor and marginalized and educating youth in the faith that they will need in order to fulfill their lives as children chosen by God's grace.

This week begins the 2016 Joliet Catholic Ministries Annual Appeal. The appeal funds the ministries of the Diocese of Joliet, as outlined in the flyer that is enclosed in this week's bulletin. Many are fed, assisted, and educated thanks to your ongoing support of the important charitable work of the Diocese of Joliet, our local Church and manifestation of Catholic's working together to respond to the needs of our time as we all strive to live well the gift of God's choice to give us life in His grace.

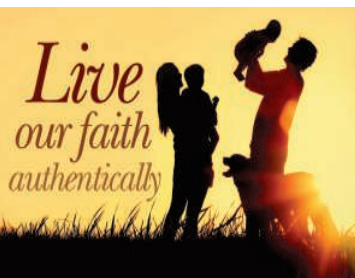

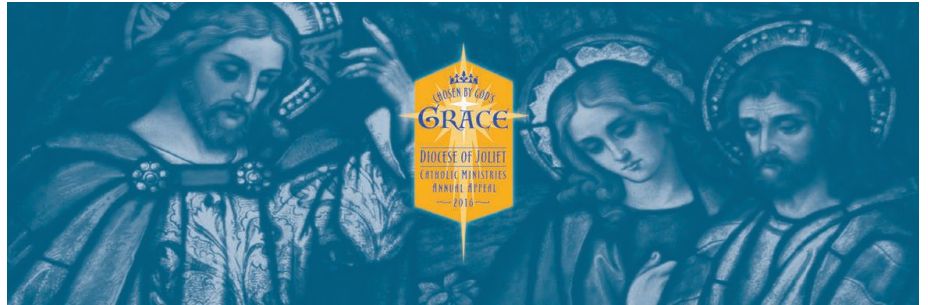

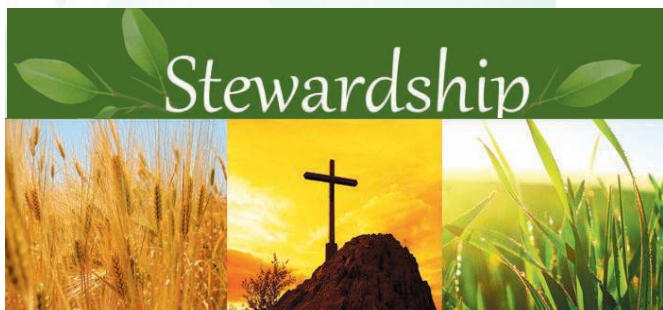
