A NOTE FROM FATHER JASON

This Wednesday begins the annual forty day retreat that we call Lent. Today's Gospel, although not connected to Lent, seems to prepare us. As we hear of the great catch of fish, we are reminded of the connection between eating fish on Fridays and the holy season we are about to begin. Although changing our diet one day a week can serve as a reminder that we are participating in the season of penance, hopefully Lent moves you to give up something more so that you can be open to receive something more. Our drive and motivation in Lent should be to create some sort of emptiness in our lives so that there is room to for the Holy Spirit to work.

As you begin to consider what extra efforts of charity you will do and what penances you will undertake through giving up, consider where the need for change is in your life. After all, the image of the abundant catch of fish is an image of the over abundance of grace that is available to you if you are courageous enough to "cast the net" into the depth of your heart and seek to rely more on God to fill the net.

Remember that others need the grace that your penances obtain and chances are someone somewhere may be fasting for you to receive some extra grace to grow in your discipleship this Lent. The potential for us to each catch an abundance of grace this Lent is beyond our imagination. So let us join Peter and the Apostles in casting into the deep and following Jesus call to offer something more so that we can be blessed with so much more, for the next 40 days and for an eternity of Easter joy.

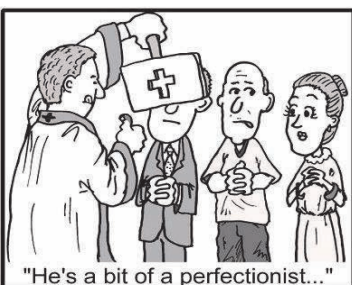

"The Christian faithful, during Lent, are clearly conscious of the need to turn our minds toward those realities which really count, which require Gospel commitment and integrity of life which, through self denial of those things which are superfluous, are translated into good works and solidarity with the poor and needy" (Directory on Popular Piety and the Liturgy, #125).

In addition to choosing their own penitential practices, Catholics are also asked to observe the practices of fast and abstinence during the 40 days of Lent. The Lenten Fast and Abstinence Regulations are as follows:

1. Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
2. All from the age of 18 years up to the beginning of their 60th year are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
3. On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
4. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.
5. Lent is the principal season of penance in the Church year. All of the faithful are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of voluntary self-denial (in addition to following the Lenten regulations), serious prayer, and a performance of works of charity and mercy.

LENTEN Q & A

COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS DURING LENT

Each week during Lent, we will highlight a frequently asked question with it's response.

- Q.** Why do we say that there are forty days of Lent? When you count all the days from Ash Wednesday through Holy Saturday, there are 46.
- A.** It might be more accurate to say that there is the "forty day fast within Lent." Historically, Lent has varied from one week to three weeks and is now 46 days. The forty day fast, however, has been more stable. The Sundays of Lent are certainly part of the Time of Lent, but they are not prescribed days of fast and abstinence; because all Sundays (not simply Easter Sunday) are days to celebrate Christ's Resurrection.

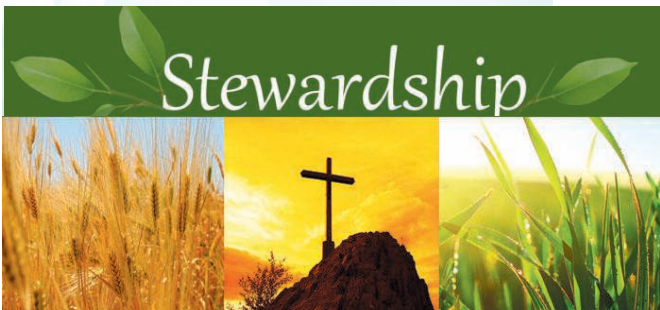

COMMUNICATION FROM THE BISHOP

COLLECTION FOR CENTRAL & EASTERN EUROPE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On Ash Wednesday, February 10, our diocese will take up the **Collection for the Church in Central and Eastern Europe**. The collection offers a way for Catholics in the United States to stand in solidarity with those who experience the ongoing effects of living under difficult circumstances across the globe.

Grants funded by this collection support pastoral projects, scholarships, and Catholic organizations working in areas formerly under Soviet control. The bishops and people of these regions still face enormous challenges in restoring church structures and in rebuilding the cultural and spiritual life of the community, tasks that are often complicated by a lack of religious freedom.

One funded group, a Czech association for women and children and the protection of unborn life (*Obcanske sdruzeni ONZ—pomoc a poradenstvi pro zeny a divky*), has worked for 24 years to reduce the rate of abortions in the Czech Republic. When the association opened its doors in 1990 after the Velvet Revolution, half of all pregnancies in the country ended in abortion. Through innovative counseling and support programs at six regional centers for women in difficult situations, the association has played a major role in reducing the abortion rate from 50 percent down to 20 percent. The centers work to protect the human dignity of both mothers and children, advocating for the right to life of the unborn.

Recently, the association experienced a crisis when the Czech government withdrew operational support for its programs. The Subcommittee on the Church in Central and Eastern Europe provided a critical bridge grant that allowed the association to continue its operations while searching for a permanent funding solution. In 2014, the Czech Bishops' Conference announced that it would fund the association's operating expenses from its own budget, thereby guaranteeing the future of the association and its crucial work.

In order for projects like this one to continue, the collection needs your help. Please be generous. Your donation will continue to restore and build the future of the Church in Central and Eastern Europe. Thank you and God bless you.
