## A NOTE FROM FATHER JASON

On the second Sunday of Lent, we hear the Gospel account of the Transfiguration of Jesus. In this scene, Jesus takes Peter, James and John, up the mountain and changes in appearance. For a few minutes, the three Apostles are privileged to see the fullness of God shining through Jesus onto them. It is a very appropriate scene for us to consider during Lent because the very thing that the Apostles experience is our goal, especially during Lent: to put our humanity aside to allow God to shine into our hearts and change us in such a way that others can see God through us.

One excellent way to allow God to work in your life this Lent is by engaging in some sort of daily reflection. You already have some possible resources for this. Last Christmas, we provided copies of Matthew Kelly's book, *Rediscover Jesus*. The book was written in 40 short chapters to provide for a reflection a day during Lent. In addition to the book, a companion website is available to help you experience the Best Lent Ever. Simply go to <http://dynamiccatholic.com/bestlentever/> to view videos and other content that goes along with the book. In addition, we provided the book of meditations, *Taking Lent to Heart*, which provides simple reflections, prayers, and actions for each day. If you missed out on receiving either resource, a limited number of extras are available in the parish office.

The other way we allow God to transfigure us is by turning the humanity of our sins over to Him, so that He can forgive and transfigure us through His grace into a new creation, freed from that sin of our past. As Catholics, we are privileged to experience forgiveness in a sacramental way, every time we confess our sins and receive absolution. Each of us should be going to confession regularly. Remember, one of the minimum expectations of a Catholic is to go to confession at least once a year, preferably in preparation for Easter. There will be many opportunities in the next several weeks to receive absolution. During this Year of Mercy, Pope Francis has called each Diocese throughout the world to make the sacrament available during a special 24 hours of Reconciliation event. The priests of Northeast DuPage County are making this unique opportunity for reconciliation available starting at 3:00 p.m. on Friday, March 4<sup>th</sup> until 3:00 p.m. Saturday, March 5<sup>th</sup> at Immaculate Conception Church. Priests will be available to hear your confession any time during those 24 hours, even in the middle of the night. In addition, additional opportunities for Reconciliation will be offered at Mary Queen on the Fridays and Saturdays of Lent and other times during Holy Week.

I hope that you take advantage of these and the many other opportunities Lent provides to allow God to transform you. May God bless you on your Lenten journey!

## LENTEN Q & A

### COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS DURING LENT

- Q.** I understand that all the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat, but I'm not sure what is classified as meat. Does meat include chicken and dairy products?
- A.** Abstinence laws consider that meat comes only from animals such as chickens, cows, sheep or pigs --- all of which live on land. Birds are also considered meat. Abstinence does not include meat juices and liquid foods made from meat. Thus, such foods as chicken broth, consommé, soups cooked or flavored with meat, meat gravies or sauces, as well as seasonings or condiments made from animal fat are technically not forbidden. However, moral theologians have traditionally taught that we should abstain from all animal-derived products (except foods such as gelatin, butter, cheese and eggs, which do not have any meat taste). Fish are a different category of animal. Salt and freshwater species of fish, amphibians, reptiles, (cold-blooded animals) and shellfish are permitted.

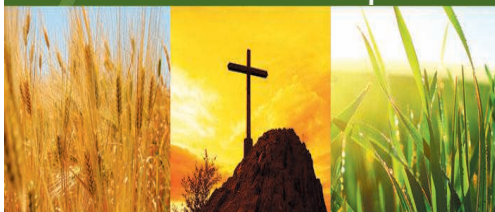

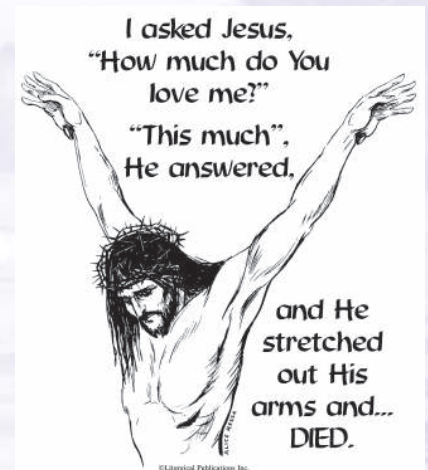
