



## FAITH FORMATION NEWS

### REDISCOVER JESUS

### CHAPTER 4

As a kid in Catholic grade school, I was always struck by the fact that whenever we were asked if we believed in Jesus, we always said yes. This was when the teachers asked us, and even when kids asked each other as a dare. Yes was the only answer. We couldn't imagine it any other way. It struck me as strange that we said yes automatically and without a reason. Being the smarty-pants that I was, I sometimes thought to myself, "Well, what if I said no?" But I quickly dismissed that thought as either being ridiculous or even dangerous.



Fast forward 40 years. What a different world! So many of my friends, classmates and co-workers are ex-Catholics, some are atheists and some just don't seem to care. There is anger at the church, people adopt Eastern philosophies, people believe in "science". Atheism is aggressively argued by many people I meet. What happened?

I think part of the problem is that we never really knew who Jesus was, we were never held accountable for a reason why we believed in Him, and we never took Him seriously. Public respect for the church is way down, substantially due to the abuse scandal. Cynicism rules. In the past 40 years public Christian tradition has mostly been rejected. Stores are open on Sunday. People workout or attend sports events instead of going to Mass. Therefore, when confronted with our current culture, we are lost. Unless we rediscover Jesus.

**Who is Jesus to you?** Is He God like he said he was? What kind of God? Is he just another guru like Buddha? Is he just another philosopher? Because the church has sinned, was Jesus a fraud? Just like our culture, you will accept Him or reject Him, but you really can't ignore Him. Indeed, I have come to the conclusion that Jesus is God, that's a boring statement. But what kind of God? That's interesting! He is an incredibly merciful and abundantly generous God, so generous I do not deserve Him – but I don't despair because his crazy love for me is so enormous he accepts me as broken and undeserving as I am, and He even laid down His life to pay for my inadequacy! My only response to this kind of God is to give Him my whole life. I cannot live without Him, I cannot be cynical about Jesus, He is too good. My faith has given me great joy and peace, but I know not everyone has this response to Him. It's time for your own grown-up answer. Who is Jesus to you?


