We are blessed to be a part of this community. As we look toward the future, let us pray that this new initiative will help build and strengthen this community whose hunger God has called each of us to feed.

Last June, I had the opportunity to visit the Holy Land. This was not a trip I necessarily planned to take, but my 86 year old mother decided she was going; and we kids decided she needed an escort. So, Israel here I come! It's funny how often God's plans for us trump our own.

Growing up Catholic laid the foundation for my beliefs, but I never really made the teachings personal. To be honest, I'm not sure I ever believed the Gospels, or more accurately gave them much critical thought until recently. What was it about this guy Jesus who claimed to be God?

In the Gospels, it says Jesus controlled nature. Jesus forgave sins and sinners. He forgave those that persecuted Him; His last act of mercy. He raised the dead and cured the sick and the blind. He claimed to be Lord of the Sabbath and reminded the Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath. He made the unpopular, the outcasts, the lowly, the poor His friends. Jesus claimed to be the Son of Man. He claimed He was God.

In Israel, with my mother, I literally walked where He walked and saw the places talked about in the Gospels. Since the trip, His life and teachings have become more personal, more real. I realized that not only are the Gospels the foundation of our Catholic faith, but they are also a historical account of Jesus' life. What He taught was love and forgiveness and His only request was this: COME, FOLLOW ME.

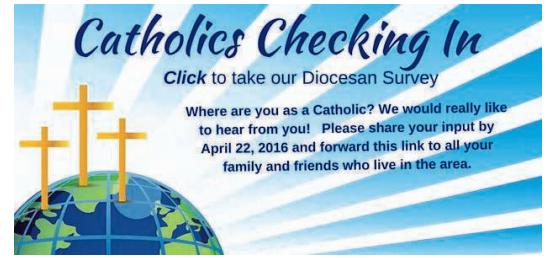

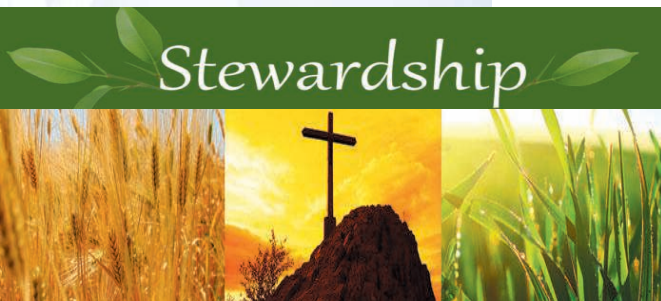
