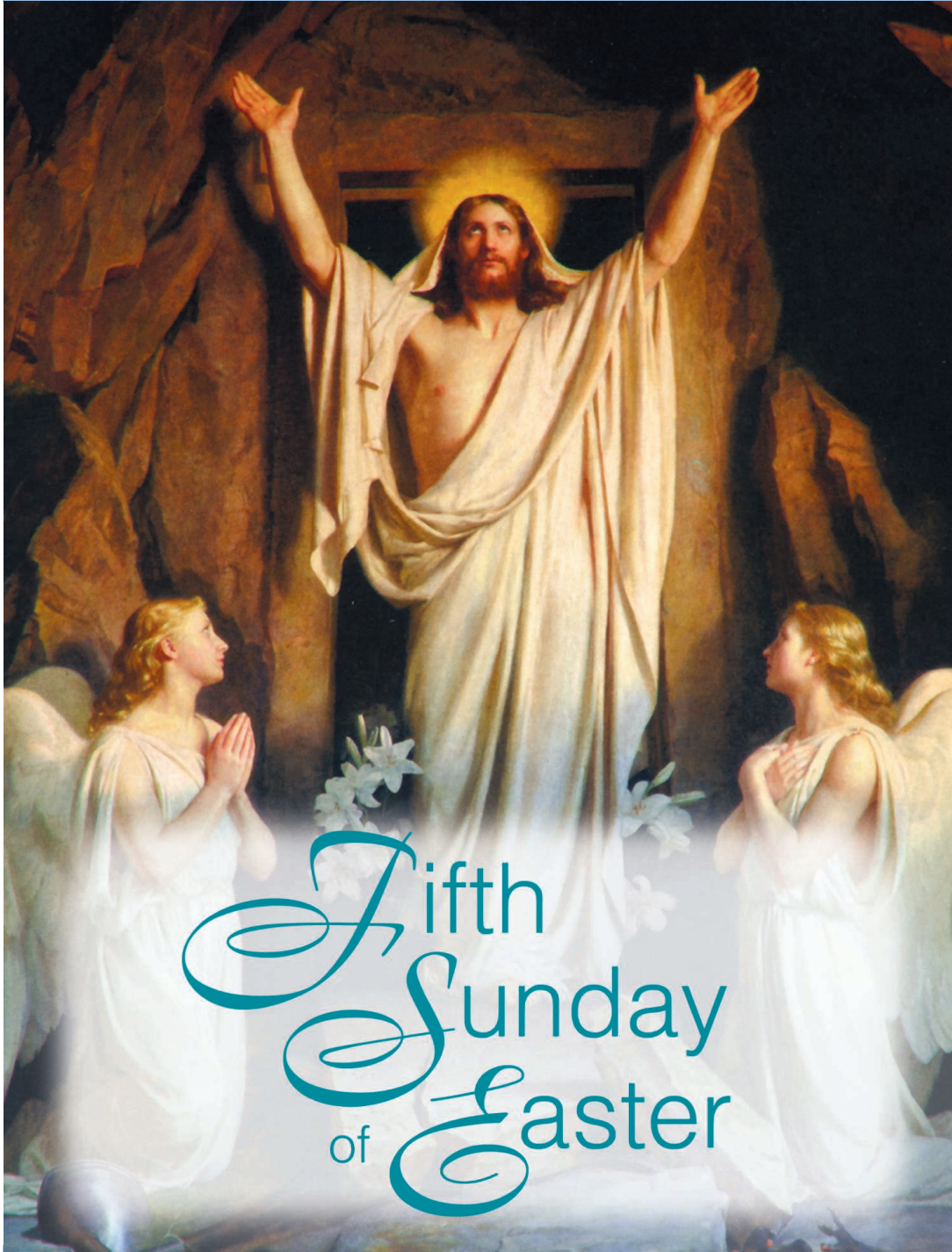

### REDISCOVER JESUS- THERE IS MORE (CHAPTER 6)

**Point to Ponder:** Knowing *about* Jesus is not the same as *knowing* Jesus.

**Verse to Live:** “Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you may discern what is the will of God – what is good and acceptable and perfect.” ROMANS 12:2

**Question to Consider:** Do you have a really good reason not to take Jesus at His word?

**Prayer:** Jesus, I believe. Help me to grow out of my doubts and unbelief.

### Parishioner Reflection: Dominic Crotty

In this chapter, Matthew Kelly expands upon the “God Claim”. Jesus also claimed to give eternal life, to see into the future, and that He preexisted the world. These claims can be tough to swallow knowing that Jesus walked the earth like you and I.

What’s good is that these claims challenge us to decide whether or not we believe in Jesus. Do I have a really good reason not to take Jesus at His word? I am willing to entertain it because of the goodness Jesus brought to the world, His excruciating death, and His resurrection – a key element. And in getting to know Jesus, I know there’s going to be an element of other-worldliness – a divine nature.

In order to discern the will of God, I cannot completely conform to this world. St. Paul spoke this with authority, and Jesus did too.

Jesus was focused on the will of God. If our hearts honestly speak to the belief of His claims, it can only draw us closer to what is good and acceptable and pleasing to God. Jesus has authority; and as Christians let’s not come to doubt that.
