
REDISCOVER JESUS - FORTY WORDS (CHAPTER 10)

Point to Ponder: God wants to raise you up.

Verse to Live: "As God's chosen ones, holy, and beloved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience." COLOSSIANS 3:12

Question to Consider: Are you loving yourself the way God wants you to love yourself?

Prayer: Jesus, begin a revolution of love in my heart today. Teach me to love myself as You love me, so that I can live all those who cross my path in a way that reminds them that You changed the world.



Reflection by parishioner Shawn Fahey

Chapter 10 begins with Mathew 22:39: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind." This is the greatest and first commandment. And the second is like it, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself". In forty words, Jesus very simply and very clearly tells us His most important teaching. Everything else flows from there.

It's pretty basic. First, put God first with all things and love Him above all else. I think about the idea of having false gods before us and in today's society. There are false gods we pay homage to everywhere; material goods, TV shows, social events, our kid's schedules, work, etc. While many of those things are important in life, we should not place their importance above His.

Second, I can't help but think of the Golden Rule. Treat other people the way you would like to be treated. Love your neighbor as yourself. Implicit in that is, Love yourself as God loves you. I think many of us are pretty hard on ourselves with negative self talk. We beat ourselves up for mistakes and judge ourselves critically. We need to cut ourselves some slack. Love and forgive yourself and do the same to others.

Rinse and Repeat.


