

PARISHIONER MESSAGE

Looking back on my 4 years in the Biblical Institute of the Diocese of Joliet (BIDJ):

I never thought I'd get through the four years of the Biblical Institute but it turned out that it became so much a part of me that I definitely am going to miss the learning, the group work, and yes, even the homework.

After studying, especially the Pentateuch, and learning about the early cultic rituals of the Israelites, I can see that my faith is directly descended from Judaism. I am always noticing little instances when I see Jewish sacrificial moments in our Mass and other liturgies. The scripture readings are so much more meaningful now that I know the context and the characters in the Bible. Anyone know who Tabitha is? Look her up.

The past years in the Biblical Institute have been the most challenging, awesome, and prayerful time I've ever experienced. The knowledge and resources have already been useful in the Bible studies I've organized, small faith group, RCIA, and parish and inter-parish events. I received a beautiful thank you note from one of our catechumens baptized at Easter. She thanked my husband and me and said, "It really helped me understand the scriptures when you guys presented footnotes and what was the 'normal' thing to do. The short video clips also helped me understand what's going on." It made me feel great that I could pull together resources from materials I had at home or on the internet, and it would help someone else as it did me.

Exercising my Christian discipleship going forward, I will be able to find ways to keep my faith strong and new, and stimulated by taking advantage of opportunities for adult faith formation to getting involved in the planning myself. It's so easy for me to become complacent and bored, when there is little to move me to action. That's why I really appreciated BIDJ, my mind was busy all the time; Bibles all over the house, (on different pages), paper Bibles, eBook Bibles, iPod Bibles, and iphone Bibles. I even had one in Chinese/English Bible to work with my RCIA Little One. She read the Chinese while I read English. I used YouTube videos to illustrate the scriptures of the day since she had never heard the stories we all take for granted growing up Catholic. I hope I can keep my BIDJ muscles flexed and ready for action, and I will be visiting the new classes!


