

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER JASON

Are you a Mary or a Martha? Anyone who has invited over guests knows that putting on a dinner party requires splitting your time between preparing the meal and entertaining the guests. In this weekend's gospel, Luke paints a scene that puts the tension between the active and the contemplative sides of faith into a sibling rivalry. And doesn't the battle between doing and contemplating find itself in a battle almost as contentious as one that happens between brothers over who will get

the last cookie. Indeed, with all of the demands on our time and distractions that we face, finding any time to follow Mary's lead of carving out some time to sit and listen to Jesus can be a struggle. It may even mean letting some of the activities that we think are important go. Doing so is challenging. Even Jesus was no stranger to this tension in His life. Several times in the Gospel, we hear how He struggled to go away and pray for a while. It is so much easier to point to check marks on a to do list than to see what time spent in prayer accomplished. And yet, it is that quiet listening that Jesus points out is "the better part." He is not saying that activity is bad. Nor is He saying that one can spend their lives in prayer without work. He is saying that it is important to realize that this tension exists in our lives and that we will have to find some time to set aside for listening if we are to hear what it is that Jesus is trying to tell us. That time of listening is important, for if we never slow down, we can never change the direction that our lives are going. Without listening, conversion will never happen.

Are you a Martha or Mary? The answer for all of us is most likely, "Yes!" If Martha like levels of activity exist in your life, find some time, however brief to slow down and listen. Take a walk while praying the rosary. Sit in your favorite chair and read the Gospel reading of the day or a book about Jesus. If all else fails, delay your collapse into the pillow for long enough to look back at the day and ask Jesus to help you see how he helped you through it. Even if it doesn't seem like time well spent, the reward will pay off in your ability to be grounded, so that your "Mary" life can have a chance against your "Martha" to do list.




