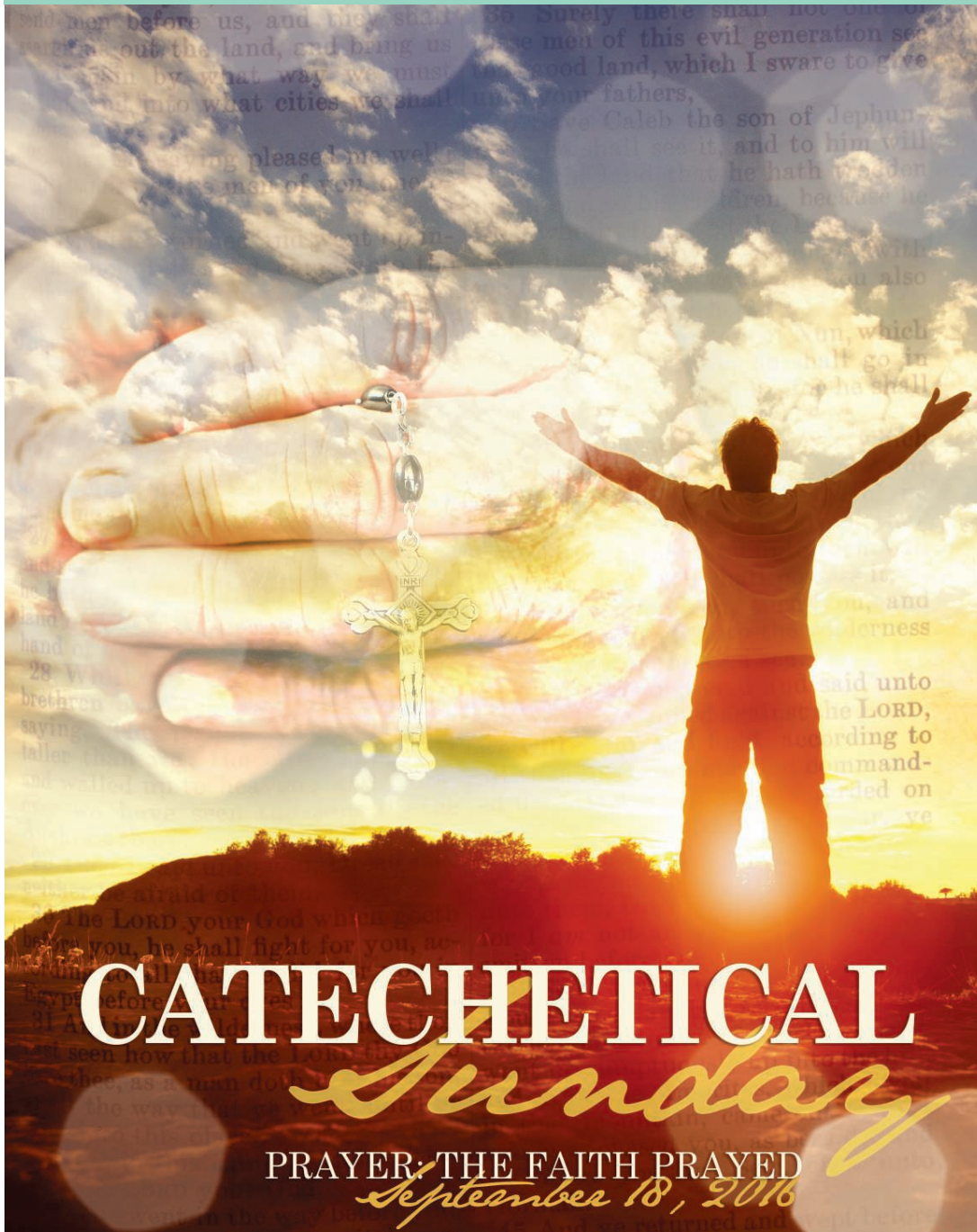

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER JASON

This weekend, as the new academic year begins, we celebrate Catechetical Sunday. We will be praying in a particular way for our students enrolled in Religious Education and our teachers and staff who will be their Catechists. Often we think of Religious Education only in terms of preparation to receive a Sacrament. However, the word catechesis reminds us that there is something deeper going on than preparation for a sacramental celebration.

Catechesis is from the Greek work that means "to echo." Our Catechists are entrusted with echoing the teaching of Jesus and his Church that has reverberated through the generations into our present day parish. God bless them for their generosity in doing so!

The task of Catechesis is not just a role reserved to those who teach in Religious Education. It is a sacred obligation for each and every one of us who ever heard the truth about Jesus in catechesis classes. It does not matter if you attended Catholic School, Faith Formation, Religious Education, RCIA or CCD, you are now a member of the chain tasked with echoing the Word to anyone who does not know Jesus. If the message has echoed for two thousand years to reach us, we certainly do not want to be the generation who neglect to pass it on for generations to come.

Let us pray that God would help us to echo the Word!

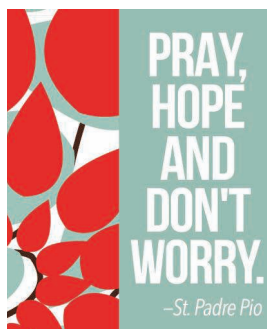
*God of our fathers and mothers,

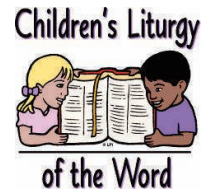

Catechists, helpers, and hall monitors are still needed in RE on Wednesdays. If you are interested in sharing your faith with young people, please call Jo at the REO.

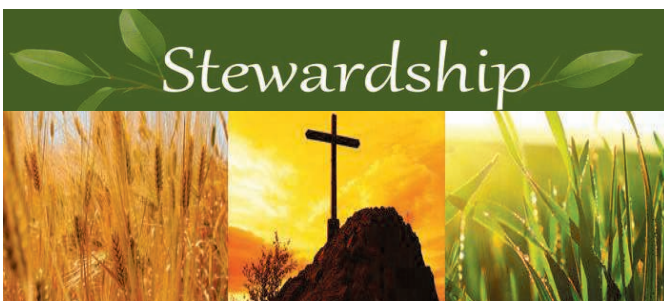
RE classes begin Wednesday, September 14! A copy of each child's Baptismal certificate (or Birth certificate if not yet Baptized) is required to be on file in the REO.

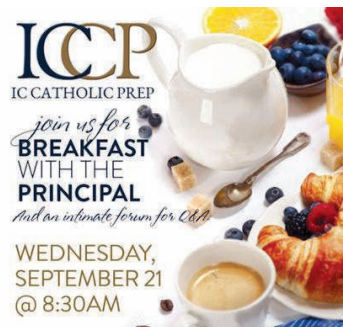
