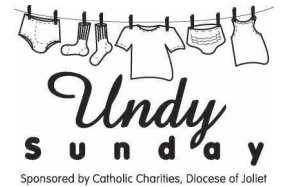

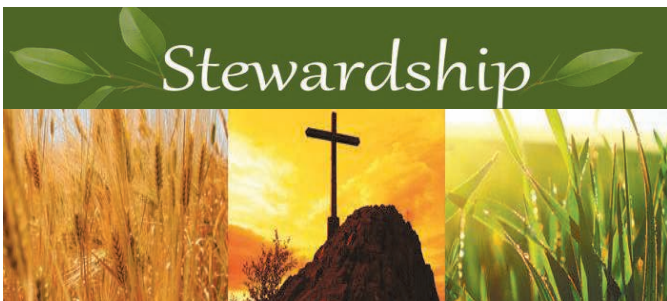
PRESCHOOL NEWS CONT'D
