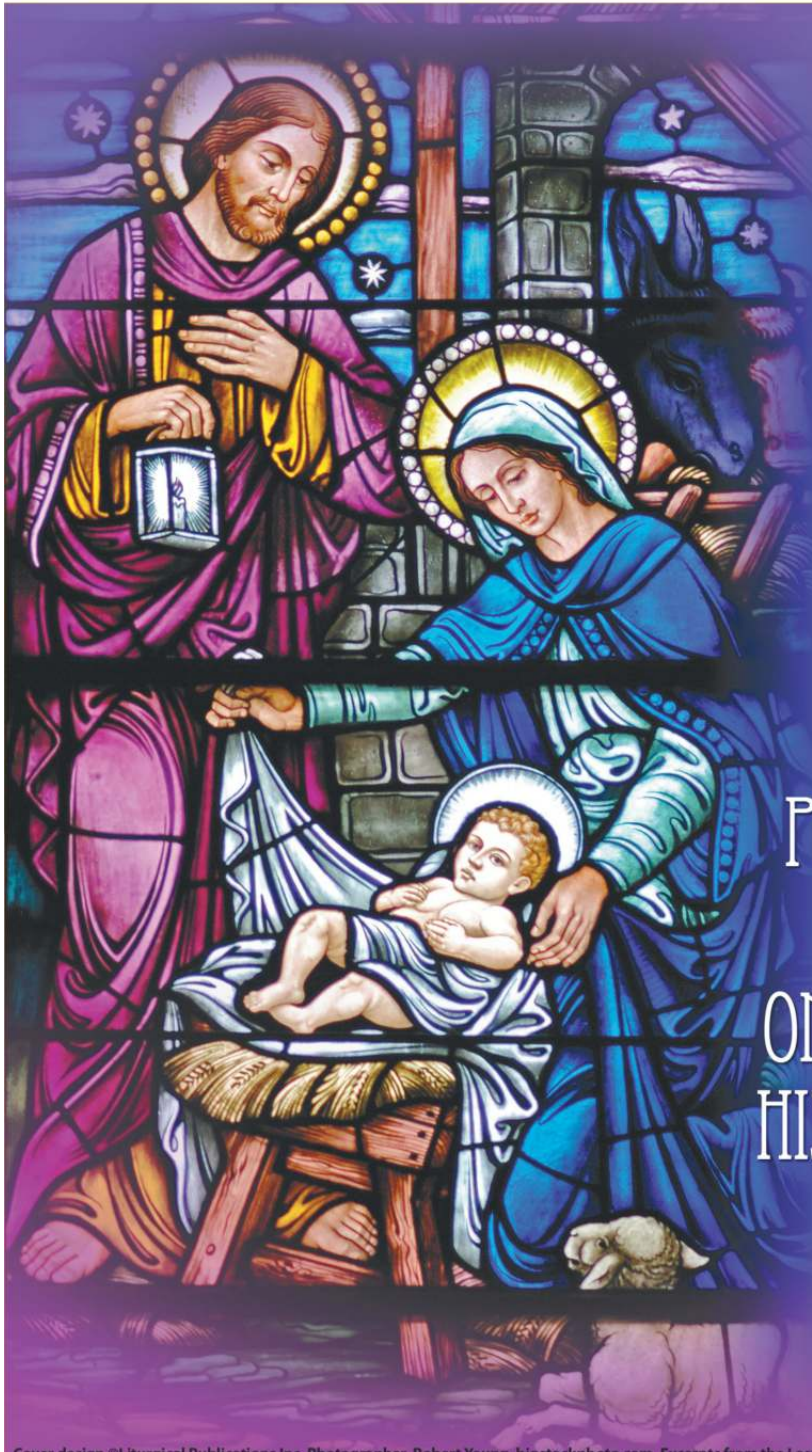

A MESSAGE FROM FR. JASON

“Glory to God in the Highest and on Earth peace to people of good will!” The angels, marveling at the beautiful event of God himself taking on flesh sing out this song at the birth of the Christ child. And all that God has created sings out each year as we celebrate that day in history when God, the infinite and beyond time, enters our world, humbling himself in a mortal body and allowing himself to be contained in time. This night is not like any other night, this birth not like any other birth, this miracle beyond any miraculous intervention that God has brought to light.

And so, even the angels are moved with joy and sing God’s praise. On that night, even their praise is not contained to the heavens, but it spills into the fields where shepherds are grazing their sheep and proclaims to them the wonderful thing God has done: “A savior has been born to you!”

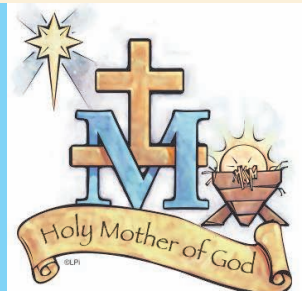

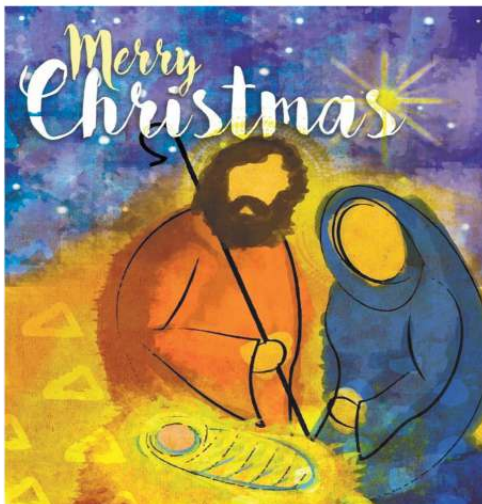

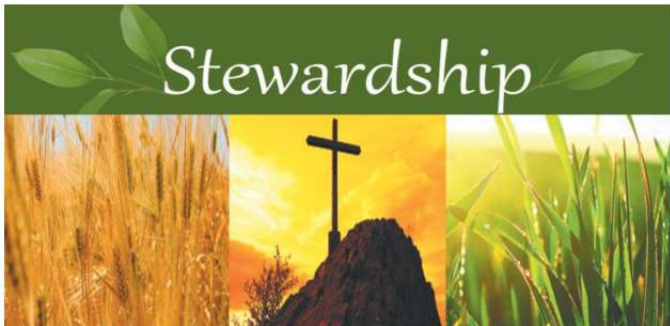
