## A MESSAGE FROM FR. JASON

Beginning this Wednesday, January 18th until the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul the Apostle on January 25th is designated as the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. The week was created to remind us of the divisions that exist between the various communities of believers that have developed over the history of the Christian era and to encourage prayers for unity.

The theme for this year's week of prayer is "The love of Christ impels us," which is taken from 2 Corinthians 5:14. Paul, in this section, which the New American Bible titles, "Ministry of Reconciliation" encourages us in the conviction that Christ died for all, so that we may "no longer live for ourselves but for him who for [our] sake died and was raised." It sounds simple enough, and chances are, if all truly lived for Christ divisions among believers would be much less profound. Unfortunately, human nature has always led to divisions, and Jesus knew this, which is likely why he prayed that we all would be one (John 17:21).

Although it would be wonderful if such divisions could just be healed by setting aside our differences and agreeing to be one, the reality is that divisions run too deep. Groups of Christians have grown apart over hundreds of years. Theologies and liturgies have taken on completely different identities. To heal such a division would take a miracle.

And so, we are called to spend this week in prayer. There is no better source of healing of divisions than the one-in-three union of persons that is our Trinitarian God. Let us pray for all Christians, that the Holy Spirit would work to help us to find common ground and work together, even though we may never be able to worship in the same building. In doing so, perhaps we can become "ambassadors for Christ" as Paul encourages us to be later in 2 Cor 5:20.

God, who are unity in three holy persons--Father, Son, and Holy Spirit--  
you have called us to live in peace with all people.

You have also called us to work toward unity in purpose  
to spread the Gospel to all nations.

Graciously give us the courage and strength to work toward unity,  
and act toward each other as brothers and sisters.

We ask this in the unity of God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Amen.
