## A NOTE FROM FATHER JASON

This weekend's readings challenge our generosity. The book of Leviticus suggests that the path to holiness is to love your neighbor as yourself. Jesus reinforces the commandment to love and be generous toward our neighbors and challenges us to not put limits on those we see as neighbor. In today's gospel, He challenges us to expand our generosity beyond our neighbors, but to be generous toward even our enemies as well. Essentially, he is challenging us to not place any limits on whom we are willing to help with their needs.

Even in Jesus' day, there was debate over the definition of brother in the commandment. He knows that great needs exist but that we often live in our closed circles of those we call family and friends. It is easy miss the needs of those who we should see as brothers and sisters, because to us they are strangers. 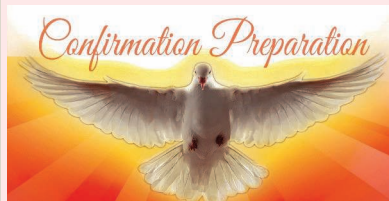
### SACRAMENT PREPARATION MANDATORY PARENT MEETINGS

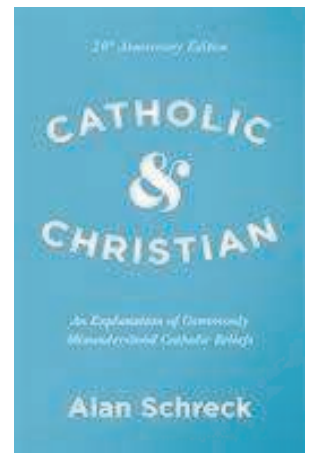
At 7:00pm, there is a mandatory meeting for the Confirmation Prep Candidates and at least one of their parents at 7:00pm in church.
