

Brothers and Sisters,

One of the noblest forms of witness that we Catholics give in our contemporary society is to stand up for the dignity of human beings as children of God. We feel a special commitment to the most vulnerable and the most innocent of all: children in the womb.

Of course, unborn children depend primarily upon the care of their mothers. But legal protection is also important, something that has been lacking in the United States for over forty-four years.

A bill has been introduced in the Illinois legislature—House Bill 40—which has two destructive purposes:

to thwart any future decision by the U.S. Supreme Court to reverse or limit Roe vs. Wade: and

to allow for the use of public money to fund the taking of innocent human lives through abortion in the state's Medicaid and health insurance programs.

It is essential that people who believe in the protection of human life in the womb contact their proper state legislators and express their **opposition** to House Bill 40. 



LENTEN REGULATIONS


"The Christian faithful, during Lent, are clearly conscious of the need to turn our minds toward those realities which really count, which require Gospel commitment and integrity of life which, through self denial of those things which are superfluous, are translated into good works and solidarity with the poor and needy" (Directory on Popular Piety and the Liturgy, #125).

In addition to choosing their own penitential practices, Catholics are also asked to observe the practices of fast and abstinence during the 40 days of Lent. The Lenten Fast and Abstinence Regulations are as follows:

- 1. Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
- 2. All from the age of 18 years up to the beginning of their 60th year are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- 3. On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
- 4. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.
- 5. Lent is the principal season of penance in the Church year. All of the faithful are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of voluntary self-denial (in addition to following the Lenten regulations), serious prayer, and a performance of works of charity and mercy.

Lenten Prayer & Worship Group

All are invited to a weekly hour of prayer and worship throughout Lent to enrich our Lenten journey. We will be praying spontaneously as the spirit leads. The first night will include an introduction to spontaneous prayer.



Come and experience joining your prayer with others outside of Mass. Bring your Bible and an open heart.

The first meeting will be Thursday, March 2, 2017 in the school building from 7:15 PM to 8:30 PM. We will continue each Thursday of Lent through April 6, 2017.
